The Military Telegraph.

The Military Telegraph.

Things happen, the world moves, despite the fact that we may seem to stand still ourselves.

Get into conversation with our oldest citizens on the subject of a railroad and you are confronted with the reminiscences of twenty years ago when there were apparently the same brilliant prospects, the same railroad talk, but still we have no railroad.

Such is the opinion of Lieut. Gov. Coleman, editor of the Missouri World, after making a tour of inspection through Texas recently.

Like Mr. Wilson, we long for the day when there shall be a reciprocity of sentiment and a Union of good will between the North and South which nothing can disrupt or misinterpret.

In politics none are more decided in their principles or their practices than ourselves, the usages of the Democratic party are as sacred to us, and regulate our conduct, as reverently and as implicitly as we receive the traditions of the Church in the formation of our religious faith and the regulation of our morals.

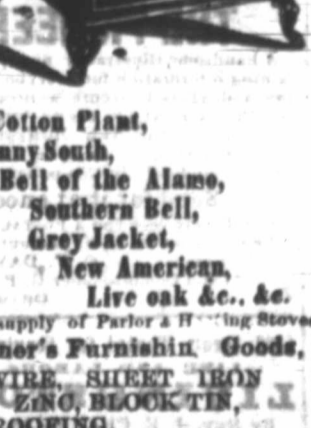
