The office of Commissioner of Pensions is one of the most important in the Government, because it not only involves large disbursements of public funds, but the equitable dealing with those named patriots and their families who braved the dangers of battle in the hour of the nation's peril. Mr. Atkinson is now in the full vigor of manhood, having been born September 20, 1829, at Wheeling, Va. At an early age he moved with his parents to Licking county, Ohio, where his youth was passed on a farm, until death called away both of his protectors when he was only 14 years of age. He was afterwards educated at New Britain High School, Connecticut, and subsequently at Dennison University, Ohio. In 1857, with true American pluck, he emigrated to Nebraska, then a sparsely settled Territory, on the borders of civilization. He took up his residence at Brownsville, where he has since resided. In 1861 he was admitted to the bar, and commenced practice immediately, but in the fall of 1862 he gave it up and enlisted as a private in the 24 Nebraska cavalry. He soon reached the position of adjutant, and remained with the regiment until 1864, when he was appointed provost marshal for the Southern district of Nebraska, which he held until the close of the war. The district under his command lying adjacent to the northern borders of Missouri and Kansas, where the murderous guerrillas of the war made their headquarters. His early military career was distinguished by his gallant conduct at the Battle of Fort Union, where he distinguished himself by his valor. He was promoted to the rank of lieutenant, and then to that of captain, and finally to that of major. He was discharged from the service in 1866, and returned to his native land, where he resumed the practice of law. He has since been engaged in the construction of railroads in Nebraska. To him, more than to any other man, is that State indebted for the development of the fine agricultural land in its interior, and for the magic increase in its population. In 1873 he was appointed special commissioner to remove roving bands of Indians from Mexico—a position requiring great executive ability and great courage when we take into consideration the unsettled condition of the Mexican border. He accomplished his work successfully. While absent in his capacity of commissioner his friends at home came within a single vote of sending him to the United States Senate. A most complimentary and deserved recognition of his worth as a Republican citizen.
