When the Fair Will be Held.

The annual Fair of the Agricultural, Industrial and Stockraising association will be held on October 13th and continue for four days. Although the time set is three months off, it is high time for every competitor to prepare and be ready for the fair. Remember, October 13th, 1875.

The Democratic District Convention which met at Fredericksburg on the 28th inst., returned to nominate for the Legislature, and nominated H. C. King, J. Waelder Esq., and A. O. Cooley as candidates for the Constitutional Convention.

The Fredericksburg Convention was a failure and although the gentlemen nominated are of a mild type of Democracy, they have had the Ireland leg pinned to their backs. It remains now for the people to meet and designate an independent ticket upon a platform declaring in favor of Free Schools and against a Convention.

News. The harmless eulogies indulged in by democratic editors, over the "best cause" are, after all, the strongest evidence. The "best cause" was a bad cause and every sensible, reflecting man knows it and acknowledges it to have been so.

If human slavery was not the "cause" then it had the merit of being no cause at all; and with the thousands of gallant Southerners who shouldered their rifles and marched to the front and fought for the "best cause," there was no reason or justification for their action only that their valor had been summoned to the test, and the innate fighting grit of the Southern people was sufficient to sustain them valiantly to the end. Had it been a "cause," such as human liberty, or resistance to tyranny, or the defence of our soil against foreign invasion, the Southern people would be fighting still, and the "cause" would only be trampled out by the extinction of the people. Had it been a cause worth fighting for, it would have been successful.

Gen. Joe Johnson in his memoirs shows that the Confederacy was one of the most tyrannical governments that ever ruled a people, and had the Confederacy met with success and overthrown the American Republic, an attempt would have been made to establish upon the ruins of the Union an aristocracy with slavery and caste as its corner stone.

The Confederacy soldier would have been called upon to sustain with his bayonet a king or a dictator. The people had become accustomed to tyranny, and victory would have found them exulting and the very cry of Jeff Davis and his practical eyes looking back over the bloody chaos, every remaining man, every patriot, every lover of human freedom and believer in a Republican form of government must rejoice that the "cause" was lost. It was a happy escape for the people of the South from a disaster far more terrible than the war itself.

The Rebellion was fanned into a flame by the rash appeals of such men as Yancy, Wigfall, and Jeff Davis; a spirit of sectional hatred was indistinctly cultivated towards the northern people; the political power of the slave owner was on the wane and the land was dragged into a fight, in which men fought blindly because they had the fight in them. On the contrary with the northern people, they came to the rescue of the Union, and the preservation of the Republic, from principle and they had a "cause" which embodied true patriotism, liberty, and the perpetuation of a government by the people; their cause carried them through.

The Question of the City Public Schools. In view of the establishment of City public Schools under the recent law passed by the Legislature, Mayor French addressed some questions to the State Superintendent, to which he has received a reply. The following is the correspondence: SAN ANTONIO, TEX., June 25, 1875. Hon. O. N. Hollingsworth, Superintendent of Public Instruction, Austin, Texas.

Sir—I have the honor to request information on the following points relating to the school law, viz: 1st. Does the act of the last Legislature, entitled "An Act to authorize the cities of Texas to maintain public schools," confer any additional power on the municipal authorities other than that heretofore possessed by the County Superintendents and Board of Directors?

2nd. Will it be required of us to take the scholastic census this year, or can we claim our present rate of State school fund on last year's census, if we so desire?

3rd. Will the city authorities be restricted in the payment of teachers' salaries per day for each scholar in actual attendance?

4th. How shall we proceed to gain control of the funds—our present rate—remaining in the hands of our County Treasurer?

5th. Can, or will we, be permitted in any event to apportion any part of our school fund to private or sectarian schools, or to any institution of learning, not under the exclusive control of the city authorities, by virtue of the act first above mentioned.

An early response to these interrogatories is respectfully requested. I have the honor to be very respectfully, Your obedient servant, J. H. FRANKS, Mayor City of San Antonio.

2nd. Your city must provide for taking the census this year—all the counties.

3rd. No salary greater than ten cents per day for each pupil in actual attendance can be allowed.

4th. The division of funds not expended must be adjusted between the City Board and the County Board.

5th. I answer no to your fifth interrogatory. Respectfully, O. N. HOLLINGSWORTH, S. S. P. E., Chief Clerk.

The most important query and answer is the fifth, to-wit: that it will not be permitted to apportion any part of our school fund to private or sectarian schools or institutions of learning. This places a veto upon certain movements to secure the city school fund to support sectarian schools. It may be the opening gun of the fight, but it is an issue we are compelled to meet and we may as well meet it now as at a later period.
