Bismarck's Plans. Bismarck is now to Europe what Louis

Napoleon was a few years ago. He sits at Berlin, an impenetrable Sphinx. He collects all men's opinions, and gives his to none; he hears all men, and says nothing; he penetrates the plans and intentions of others, while he keeps the vail of secrecy drawn over his own operations till it is lifted by the naked sword. To understand him, we must understand Germany; he is the embodiment of the German spirit, Under his management, Prussia has grown from a second-rate power to be the first military nation in Central Europe. By his skillful manipulation she has ceased being kicked about by her neighbors, and has learned the happy art of kicking them. How he has done this is known to all the world. The natural enemy of Prussia is France, In the first rencontre, under Napoleon Bounparte, France was victorious and Prussis completely humbled. Then came Sedan, when the tables were turned. It is France who now cherishes the thoughts of retribution, and who is preparing for revenge. Against France, Prussia must watch night and day. Eternal vigilance, the price of liberty, is also the price of no ting behind. dominion, and France, from present indications, is going to improve the first op portunity of wreaking vengeance on her old enemy. There is many an orator in the French Assembly that nurses the same and Flour; To accommodate all who prefer the French Assembly that nurses the same spirit as Cato of old, and closes every speech with the mental exclamation, "Berlin must be destroyed." But how this is to be done is the problem they are attentively considering. The French alone cannot do it, will hardly venture to attempt it. They must have allies. To provent all alliances which might entangle Prussia with new foes, we may reasonably suppose to be a principal part of Bis marck's present plans.

An alliance of Austria with France would no doubt be very acceptable to the latter, but whether Austria, almost surrounded as she is by Prussian territory. could afford, or would even dare, to enter into such an alliance, is questionable spain and Portugal could enter into allimee with nobody, for the plain reason that they could render nobody any service; while iteliand and Belgium will be very loath to side with France, for they would have belimeted troops marching along their highways, and Prussian guns thundering at their gates within twentyfour hours after the declaration of war, and a large part of the whole contest would be waged in their territory. Italy might take the part of France, but, on account of her geographical position and weakness, sould do very little; while Turkey, in the presence of Russia, dares not call her soul her own. Russia will go into no war for the benefit of the French, for she remembers too well the burning of Moseow and the siege of Seleastopol, and, besides, has other designs which she wishes to carry out untrammeled. The only possible alliance that France can count on obtaining is with England. England is jealous of the growing influence of Prus sia on the continent, and will take any means to parry the arm that she fears will te raised to strike her. The "Battle of Dorking" has aroused the British to a sense of the danger that they fear is impending, and they wish to be prepared and in time. Nevertheless, even England will be slow to engage in any war: for while Russia maintains the atitude she Ages at present, the East India possessions will be in danger. Russis, seeing Bogistel thoroughly shiftsted with France in contimental war, will push her eagles south and southeast, taking Turkey at a mouth ful, and never stopping autil the whole of Hindoman has, from the most valued and valuable of the English possessions, been metamorphosed into a Russian prevince. There is probably an implied, if not indeed a written anderstanding bebetween Russia and Prussia, that as long as Prussia is lett alone in Enrope, Russia shall not be melested in her Asiatic pro-

The principal plan of the German Chancellor, so far as we can arrive at it from appearances and probabilities—for he has told nothing, nor ever will—seems to be, by fear or diplomacy, to deter the other European nations from the struggle, and to keep England in such a state of slarm for the East Indies that she will have no inclination to form a perilous alliance. If this really be his plan, in it he has, so far, admirably succeeded. England stood by and saw Denmark almost blotted from the map of Europe, saw Austria's dominione mirrowed, eaw France bumbled. ground to the dust, and did no more than utter a feeble protest. 
