LUMBER IN WEST TEXAS.—We have had our attention called to the large prospect of lumber business in this city.

"There was a time when what little lumber was used here was hauled from Texas in heavy wagons, and even from Montgomery county.

"This lumber nearly all comes from the pines of Walker and Montgomery counties, which is shipped down the Great Northern to Houston, and from thence to this point on the Central.

"About one-third of the entire amount of lumber which comes to this point is consumed by the city, and it speaks well for the improvement of the surrounding country that the new lumber markets which have been opened at Luling and Rockdale, though they compete successfully with our city in price and out of a very considerable portion of our territory, have not reduced to any material extent the receipts of the lumbermen here.
