Hon. John Hancock.

Member of Congress from the Austin District, is doing good service for Western Texas in the matter of securing us good mail service. The letter from the Second Assistant Postmaster General, addressed to him on that subject, in response to the memorial of our Board of Trade, will be found in this issue of the Express, and will be read with great interest.

We supported Judge Hancock for Congress, against the opinion of some of our best friends, and we do not regret it. We did not support Mr. Schlicher, our own member, but he is a well informed gentleman, and we trust he and Judge Hancock will co-operate in labor until Western Texas has simple mail facilities. Let the people of Western Texas support the Postoffice Department, and look to it for what they want, and not to speculating contractors. The Department seeks to do the best it can for us, and has no motive to do otherwise; the contractors think only of themselves, and care nothing either for the interests of the people or the Government.

Our Dyspeptic Neighbor.

The Express has repeatedly urged that Texas, and Western Texas particularly, should be represented at the Centennial next year at Philadelphia. We have done this not only for patriotic reasons, but also for the promotion of the material interests of our State, and of our section of it. A proper representation of Western Texas at that world's assembly will be a better advertisement for our region, and do more to incite immigration, and the investment of capital among us, than all that our newspapers could say for the next five years.

But our neighbor, the Herald, opposes all this, because the late war went against us, and because all the Northern people do not think about it as the editor of the Herald does. That paper presents a long indictment against the Northern people, and wishes to remain separate from them. But this is merely a chronic complaint of the Herald, which breaks out periodically. It talks the same way about the Democratic party of middle, eastern, and northern Texas, and grows to be delivered from occasion with these airs.

We beg our neighbor to quit all this morbid complaining and abuse. It is an act of moral dyspepsia that is bad enough anywhere, but is ruinous in journalism. The people are sick and tired of quarreling, and would all get in a good humor with each other, and live like brethren, if the dyspeptic newspapers would let them alone. Take things easily. We are all well and doing well. Let us "thank God and take courage."

THE CONVENTION.

Fourth Day. THURSDAY, Sept. 9th, 1875.

The President announced the Committee on Millage as composed of Martin de Navarro, Abernathy and Staton. Mr. West presented a resolution asking the Governor and Secretary of State to present the Convention with a tabular statement of the votes in the different counties in the elections for Governor in 1860, 1869 and 1873, and other information in regard to the present voting strength of the State; also the present registration of the State, and general information about the expense of said elections.

Mr. Darnell presented a resolution to protect the separate and community property of the wife; also, to provide for the registration of the separate property of the wife; also, for a law more clearly defining property rights of the wife. He also presented a resolution requiring certain property of the heads of families to be protected from forced sale, homestead not to exceed 250 acres of land in the country; and town lots not to exceed—dollars, nor shall the owner, if a man, be permitted to alienate the same. Also a resolution limiting the legal rate of interest to eight per cent. All referred to the Committee on General Provisions.

Mr. Fleming presented a resolution requiring railroad corporations to make annual statements, under oath, of all their acts and doings as may be prescribed by law. All rolling stock, etc., to be regarded as personal property; that the Legislature shall regulate and compel rates of travel and freight; that no law shall ever be passed exempting the property of railroads from taxation and sale; that railroads are public highways, and shall be free to all persons for the transportation of passengers and freight; rates for passage and freight shall be regulated by legislative enactment. Also, a resolution to limit the rate of interest on money to ten per cent. Both referred to appropriate committees.

Mr. Nugent presented a resolution that habeas corpus shall never be suspended. Also, for curtailing the necessity for the employment of juries in civil cases.

Mr. Lynch presented a resolution to inquire into the right to limit suffrage to those paying a poll tax. Referred to Committee on Suffrage.

Mr. Johnson of Franklin presented a resolution looking to the prohibition of individuals, companies or corporations being granted donations of public money. Referred to Committee on Legislative Department.

Mr. Moore of Fayette presented a resolution bearing upon the sale of county school lands—that said lands are absolutely vested in the counties, and that the proceeds from the sale of such lands be applied to the purposes intended. Referred to Committee on Counties and County Lands.

Mr. Wade presented a resolution looking towards the perpetuation of habeas corpus; and another to prevent city or town corporations making donations to sectarian institutions of learning. Both referred to appropriate committees.

Mr. Burison presented a resolution that the Governor shall appoint the Judiciary. Supreme Judges to hold ten years, and District Judges to hold six years. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

Mr. Flourmy presented a resolution to inquire into the rights of the Galveston Wharf monopoly, and to send for persons and papers for investigation of the rights of this company. Referred to Committee on Private Corporations.

Mr. Holt presented a resolution, that the Judiciary be elected by the people. Referred to Committee on Judiciary.

Mr. Hanson presented a resolution, that the Constitution of 1845 be the basis for the guidance of the work of the Convention.

Mr. Allison presented a resolution that a committee on apportionment be appointed to take into consideration the basis of representation. Amended by Brown of Dallas and referred to committee.

Mr. Holmes presented a resolution against the extension of aid to railroads and education.

Mr. Haynes presented a resolution in regard to the election of presiding officers in the Legislature, and making a quorum two-thirds of the Legislature.

Mr. Brown, of Dallas, desired county seats to be the points from which distances should be measured to and from the capital.

Mr. Lynch presented a resolution to abolish the office of State Geologist. Referred.

Mr. McLean presented a resolution looking to equalization of taxation, and for the abolition of occupation taxes.

Mr. Daboney submitted that representatives of the press giving reports in their publication or the proceedings of the Convention be provided with seats at the reporter's stand. Adopted.

Mr. Wade presented a resolution condemning malversation and other misdemeanors in office, and requiring the Legislature to put laws in force such as will stop corruption in office.

Mr. Wade presented a resolution that venality, malversation and malfeasance are destructive to good morals, and that it be made a high misdemeanor for officers to be influenced by gifts, bribes or otherwise. Referred to Committee on Executive Department.

Mr. Nugent presented a resolution to incorporate in the Constitution that offenses of a high grade than felony shall not be subject to a trial by jury, unless the parties interested make application for the same. Referred to Committee on Legislative Department. Also, a resolution looking towards the entire maintenance of juries in all civil cases of misdemeanor at the expense of individuals. Referred to Legislative Department.

Mr. Haynes presented a resolution authorizing the Legislature to pass laws in regard to farming, fencing and stockraising.

Mr. McCormick presented a preamble for the Constitution in which Divinity is recognized.

Mr. Staton's name was added to the Committee on Railroads Corporations. Mr. Clin's name was added to the Committee on Education. Mr. Davis, of Brazos, was added to the Judiciary Committee. Mr. Russell, of Harrison, was added to the Committee on Taxation and Revenue. Mr. Flourmy was added to the Committee on Private Corporations. Mr. Russell, of Wood, was added to the Committee on Immigration.

Inflation

Is giving the Pennsylvania Democracy great trouble. They are in Convention and have been debating the currency plank in their platform for several days without being able to agree. The resolution before the committee on resolutions, and on which the committee is about equally divided, reads as follows: "That the contraction of money and currency heretofore made by the Republican party, and the further contraction proposed by it with a view to a forced resumption of specie payment, has already brought disaster to the business of the country and threatens general bankruptcy, and whilst we expressly iconiculate and state the principle that sound currency should be gold and silver, and redeemable therein, we are opposed to either a contraction or inflation of the present currency."

The dispatches state that the committee stands 25 to 26 on the resolution. We suppose this means 25 for it and 26 against it, and the inference is that the 26 are in favor of a strong inflation utterance, though this is strong enough in all conscience. To speak in favor of specie currency, and at the same time oppose resumption of specie payment, is a dodge that ought to deceive nobody. The rank and file in the Union play this in its apparent game.

Correspondence.

A DELIGHTFUL COUNTRY—KEER COUNTY—THE EXPRESS. KEVILLIA, KEER CO., Sept. 6, 1875.

EDITORS EXPRESS: This pleasant village is beautifully situated upon the river waters of the Guadalupe, and as a health resort in summer is unsurpassed by any place in Texas. There is scarcely any sickness here at all. A gentleman with a large family of children told me to-day that he had lived here thirteen years and never had occasion to call a physician.

The table set by Mr. Hughes, the proprietor of the hotel here, abounds with vegetables, and is superior to most of the hotels kept at places of this size. The air is pure, the climate delightful, and the mountain scenery most beautiful. The rides in any direction present such a constant variation of scenery, that the miles seem remarkably short.

This is a first class country, being exceedingly well watered. Both large springs of pure cold water gush from the mountains in every direction, and it is a luxury at this season of the year to be greeted every mile or so with the murmuring sound of some limpid cool spring.

The valley of the Guadalupe is not very wide, and between here and Comport, eighteen miles below this, is one of the prettiest little valleys in the world.

A stranger in coming here is struck with the quiet orderly character of the place. It is very different in this respect from most frontier towns. This place has a good comfortable church, a fine Masonic Hall, and the county is building a very substantial Court-house which, being built of the fine rock only one-half mile distant, will present a beautiful appearance.

Last week we took a drive up on the "Divide" and stopped at the ranch of the Messrs. Knott, which is beautifully situated by the side of one of the finest of those springs mentioned above, and beneath the shade of fine large walnuts. There are two Knott Brothers, both bachelors, but they know how to live. They have a garden which, when necessary, they can irrigate from the spring, and four vegetables I never ate in San Antonio. The garden will compare favorably with those in San Antonio.

While stopping at Mr. Knott's we visited the Rangers under the command of Capt. Caldwell. They are camped some eighteen miles from here, and although they seem to succeed more in keeping them away than catching them; which is really what the frontier needs. The men are all frontiersmen and understand their business. We spent nearly two days at Mr. Knott's enjoying ourselves very much and made a visit which will long be remembered.

Politics here seem to be very quiet, the majority of the people are in favor of a division of the State and that at the present time. They say the East has always been opposed to giving them adequate frontier protection, and that now the East has succeeded in making the State pay for all the Railroads she needs—she probably in the present Constitutional Convention will insist that the time has come to stop all subsidies and land grants to Railroads, for fear that Western Texas may possibly derive some benefit which she may possibly have to help pay for.

The Express is spoken of under its present management in the highest terms. The citizens are forming a club which may reach you with this mail. From the number which I heard express themselves as intending to subscribe, I think you will receive a list of names that will convince you that the Express is appreciated.

The Dedication Yesterday. Yesterday afternoon, at 5 o'clock, according to direction in the published programme, large crowds of people from all quarters of the city began to press towards the Jewish Temple, fronting on Travis Square, to witness the dedication. The beautiful building was soon filled to the utmost capacity of its permanent seats, and the aisles and all vacant spaces were filled with chairs to accommodate the ever increasing throng.

The congregation present was composed indiscriminately of Jews and Christians, Protestants and Catholics, and all joined reverently and devoutly in the solemn and impressive religious services of the hour. The only difference between them was that the Christians included, mentally, in their participation in the service, faith in Jesus as the Christ, while the Hebrews "looked for another." It was an honest and unadventurous difference, held on both sides in the most charitable and good feeling. And this friendly intermingling of Israelites and Christians in the same public worship, so unusual and yet so friendly, hearty, seemed to impress all thinking persons present as prophetically significant of a vast and glorious change for the better in the temper in which religious questions are discussed.

As showing the kindly feeling manifest upon the occasion, we may mention that the magnificent choir which did the splendid singing during the service, was composed of Jewish ladies and gentlemen, and ladies and gentlemen from the Christian choir, and from the German singing societies.

Mrs. Neal, the wife of the Presbyterian Pastor, and the splendid contralto of the choir of that church, was one of the singers; Miss Napier, the fine soprano of that choir, was another; Mr. Morton, the powerful bass of that choir, was another; Prof. Gaardly, now teaching music there, came in with his excellent tenor part, and Maj. Karber, of the Casino Maennerchor, with his fine tenor, also assisted in the most difficult parts.

The Christian clergy of the city were given reserved seats near the pulpit, and those who attended cordially greeted Dr. Gutheim at the conclusion of the service, in response to his elegant and touching greeting to the Christians in the exordium of his discourse.

The impression upon the audience made by all these things was profound and tender. We confess that, for ourselves, we were never more deeply impressed with the exceeding excellence and beneficent influence of friendship, brotherly kindness and charity, notwithstanding the most radical and irreconcilable differences of opinion, in all our lives. We trust never to forget the lesson of yesterday.

The gentlemen of the press were given reserved seats, alongside the Christian clergy, and treated with the respect due their responsible calling.

We belong to that class of Christians who do not believe in the efforts sometimes made to convert Jews to the Christian faith. God has a special charge of that wonderful people, as much so now, and in all their dispersions, as he had in the days of Abraham, Moses, and David. Human wisdom cannot divine His purposes in regard to them, nor assist Him in His counsels. Let a Jew be a true Jew, and a Christian a true Christian, and stand in their respective lots until the time of the "restoration of all things."
