"Amazingly modern" is the term Johnson uses to describe the newer textile mills visited. "Living, standards, modes

are far behind our own," he says, "but quite a bit of their textile industry is equipped with the best machinery money
can buy." can buy."

Johnson believes chances for increased sales of High Plains Johnson beieeves chances for in
type cotton are especially bright.
"Many of the end products being manufactured on this equipment can be made from shorter staple, lower quality
cottons than are now being used, with no sacrifice of product quality
If we prove this to them and show them the potential
saving in raw material costs," he continues. "it's highly possible there would be some significant switching to West exas cottons from the more expensive growths of other areas."
Asked about the prospects for furnishing this proof Johnson said PCG does not now have the financing to do the
job alone, but could and would be able to job alone, but could and would be able to make some progress
in that direction by working with other organizations, trade people and
