TRANSFER OF THE INDIANS

EDITOR WASHINGTON CHRONICLE: SIR: There is every reason why the proposed transfer of the Indians to the army should not be made.

The presence of troops is always a guarantee of the Indian and, in times of peace, demoralizing in nearly every instance.

It is doubtful whether, beyond the simple pay of agents—which in the aggregate, is but a small sum—a single dollar would be saved.

Depend upon it, Mr. Editor, there can be no economy in the transfer, and no hope of the advancement of the Indians in education and the industrial pursuits if they are now put under the War Department.

Mr. Cox never spoke more wisely and more to the point than in his speech on this subject, and whatever may have been the shortcomings of Indian agents in the past, it is the testimony all over the nation that the agents are, as a rule, an excellent class of men, and the Indians were never before so well and honestly cared for.

To now disturb and alarm them by a transfer to an entirely new control would, in my candid judgment, (after a recent and extended tour of observation in the far West,) seriously interrupt their advancement and, in not a few instances, break their hearts.
