of Cornwall revenue has risen from £22,000 in 1874 to £73,000 to-day, and increases at the rate of about £2,000 a year; but it is probable that the increase will ere long take a sudden leap to a much larger sum, by the falling in of leases, and that the income from this source will render a future notice of Wales independent of a Parliamentary grant.

Moreover, there is good reason to suppose that the royal family of England will, like the house of Orleans, be rendered very independent of Parliamentary grants. The principal time to come by the immense property they will inherit from Queen Victoria, who must be one of the wealthiest persons in the world, quite apart from her state revenue. Not only does she own the valuable properties of Coburg and Saxe-Coburg (the latter more than 25,000 acres), both of which, although not a source of revenue, would still for immense sums, but her accumulation of property must be colossal. In many persons who have been bred under peculiar difficulties—and the very money which brought her mother's death to England is given to her as a dowry—her Majesty's expenditure has always been exceedingly careful. No establishment in the world has been conducted with more thorough economy than hers, and since the death of the Prince Consort and her consequent retirement, an immense saving has been effected in her expenditure. Of her £385,000 a year, it was arranged at the beginning of her reign that all except £96,000 should be devoted to the three great departments of her household. Of the £289,000, £200,000 a year was for her "private" or "household" expenses, and £89,000 a year for "contingencies." But the retiring manner in which the Court has lived of late has reduced the expenditure so much that it may be doubted if this £289,000 a year has been touched. Indeed, whether a great portion of the sums allotted to the Lord Stewart, Lord Chamberlain, and Master of the Horse, has ever been used. There is, for instance, no need now for half of the horses formerly kept, and it is notorious that when more are needed, they are hired from livery stables. But besides all these sources of revenue, the Queen has yet another—very considerable—ecclesiastical, by name Neill, who died in 1832, left her property amounting to over £500,000. Here is at least \$20,000 a year.

It will thus be seen that, while her means have increased, her expenditure has greatly diminished. In the way of charity she dispenses a good deal, but by no means profuse, her subscriptions being, in his respect, slightly in excess with those of the late Queen-dowager. For instance, she only subscribed £100 on the occasion of the dreadful floods in England last year, while the Duke and Duchess of Edinburgh gave a like amount. Her presents, moreover, are apt to be very little like what might be expected to come from such a source. But, be it remembered, almost her first act on coming to the throne was to pay her father's debts, and she has since had a debt herself, and now probably, with prudent eye, she is making a provision which will ensure a careful economy to be blessed by her son's subjects. GEN. REYNOLDS INDIGNANT.

WASHINGTON, April 14.—There is a good deal of uneasiness among the friends of some of the persons charged with important duties, or who have not been successful in the examinations before the Clymer Commission. They have not been given the opportunity to explain their conduct, and are thus given a chance to be misunderstood. This feeling is particularly earnest among the friends of Gen. J. Reynolds, who was charged with serious offenses in McCook's testimony. His friends say that upon his return from the Indian expedition he promptly denied the charges, and asked for an opportunity to be heard, which has not been accorded him. Inquiry shows that he telegraphed Mr. Clymer on the 3d inst., as follows: "FORT D. A. RUSSELL, W. T., April 3, 1876.—Hon. H. Clymer, House of Representatives: Retiring from the field last night, I saw for the first time the testimony of Gen. McCook before your committee, on the 23d of March. It is absolutely false so far as it refers to my being in any manner in connection with contractors, or having received valuable presents from them. (Signed) J. J. Reynolds, Colonel 3d Cavalry." On the same day he addressed the Adjutant General, saying that he had telegraphed Mr. Clymer, and expressed the hope that his denial would receive the same publicity as the testimony. He added: "If there is any report of such an inspection as Lieut. Col. McCook refers to on file in the War Department, I have the honor respectfully to request a copy of such part of it as refers to me, or to have access to it in some manner. If anything detrimental to my reputation has been officially reported, I have never known it. I am certainly entitled

to be heard before being condemned. It is understood that the contract referred to by Gen. McCook was once investigated by Gen. Sherman, and nothing objectionable in the contract of Gen. Reynolds was found.

STARTLING DISCOVERIES IN ARIZONA—THE RUSH FOR THE WHITE MOUNTAINS OF THE WEST.

LEAVENWORTH, Kan., April 14.—Advices from Tucson, Arizona, state that rich placer mines have been struck in the White Mountains, which promise to yield fabulously. The report further says that one man took out in one day, gold to the amount of \$20,000, and the mine had not been fairly touched. All the streams in and around the White Mountains are very productive, and as much as \$5,000 have been brought into Tucson by one man in a single week. The entire population of Arizona Territory is in a state of excitement bordering on frenzy, and it seems entirely probable that the reports regarding the richness of the newly-discovered mines are true, as many old and experienced miners have corroborated them. The rush for the White Mountains has already begun, and even up in California the excitement runs high. Every specimen so far brought into Tucson from the gold field in the White Mountains has the true color, and the quality of the best.

THE BRAZILIAN EMPEROR.

HIS ARRIVAL AT NEW YORK AND CORDIAL RECEPTION. NEW YORK, April 15.—The steamship Herolines, bearing the Emperor and the Empress of Brazil, entered the lower bay about noon. The batteries fired a salute of one hundred guns in honor of the royal party, and the Brazilian corvette honored the Emperor by a royal salute, as did the United States frigate Minnesota. Secretaries Fish, Robinson and Taft, Vice Admiral Bowan, Gen. Sherman, the Brazilian Minister, with Brazilian Centennial Commissioners, and a large party met the Emperor in the Steamer Alert. Custom House and city officials went down the bay in a Government cutter and tendered the hospitalities of the city, made through Mayor Wickham. The marine band, on the alert, greeted the Emperor with the Brazilian national hymn, and Secretary Fish made a brief address of the welcome. The Alert was joyfully decked with flags and the Imperial ensign was run to the main top. Flugs on all public buildings and hotels are flying in honor of the Emperor's arrival.
