THE CHINESE EMPIRE

A San Francisco correspondent of the Washington Chronicle, are discussing the Chinese question in California, gives the following interesting sketch of the Chinese Empire;

The Manchoo-Chinese Empire stands fourth in extent, containing, with all its dependencies, an area of 3,372,343 square miles, or more than ten times the area of the United States.
