THE OCCUPATION TAX

Under law imposing an Occupation Tax, it is imperative upon persons engaged in business to pay the same in advance to the Collector of the same. The State Tax Collector, (now Deane) places bring his receipt, the penalty of doing business without the tax is heavy, and the Collector is not under any obligation to refund the tax if it is not paid in advance.
