THE NORWEGIAN STAFF AT THE CENTENNIAL EXHIBITION IS SO LIFE-LIKE THAT A BROOKLYN MAN ACTUALLY ADDRESSED ONE OF THE FIGURES, BUT DID NOT DISCOVER HIS MISTAKE IN TIME TO KEEP THE FACT FROM BEING NOTICED.

A CASE OF THIS KIND WAS TRIED RECENTLY IN VERMONT. A BRIGADE OF DOCTORS TESTIFIED THAT THE EFFECT OF COPIOUS PORTIONS OF BEER WAS AN INTENSE DROWSINESS, WHICH COULD NOT BE CALLED DRUNKENNESS, AND THE JURY ACQUITTED THE PRISONER WHO HAD BEEN CHARGED WITH A VIOLATION OF THE PROHIBITORY LIQUOR LAW FOR HAVING A KEG OF LAGER BEER IN HIS POSSESSION. IT IS EVIDENT THAT A DISCRIMINATION WILL HAVE TO BE MADE IN THIS MATTER, AS SOME MEN BECOME HIDEOUSLY DRUNK ON TWO GLASSES OF BEER, WHILE OTHERS CAN POUR IT DOWN BY THE GALLON AND WALK AS STRAIGHT AS AN ARROW.
