THE MEXICAN REVOLUTION.

The State Gazette of the 2nd instant publishes a lengthy discourse pronounced by Judge Monte in the Supreme Court of Justice upon the appeal of Manuel Blain, a citizen of Mexico, against a sentence pronounced against him by the President for daring to express his sentiments in the public prints of the Republic...

The following is the manifesto: FELLOW CITIZENS—Having formed the resolution to take up arms in order to overthrow the government of Don Sebastian Lerdo we have done so for the following reasons:

That said functionary has not executed the duties imposed upon him by having been placed in the presidential chair by a vote of the people, that duty was to respect the Constitution, to give ample liberty to the press, and to promote material improvements...

That Don Sebastian Lerdo de Tejada has monopolized all lucrative enterprises, speculating in various markets, and has levied a tariff on the Vera Cruz railroad, and has obstinately opposed the project of those companies that have come to the country to establish railways...

That Don Sebastian Lerdo de Tejada, neglecting his public duties, has dedicated the office of his government by passing in the most despotic manner, living solely in feasting and revelling.

That Don Sebastian Lerdo de Tejada has abused for his own advancement, the principle of universal suffrage, on which are based our free institutions, consulting at every risk, that Representatives and Senators in Congress should be exclusively his partisans...

That Don Sebastian Lerdo de Tejada has caused to be passed vexatious and abusive laws, and has been done in that known in the sealed paper act, which relates to the independence of the State...

That Don Sebastian Lerdo de Tejada has removed at discretion, the governors of States, by the most shameful intrigues, when they have not been in excessive sympathy with his policy of depressing liberty and centralizing power.

That he has invested subaltern military officers, occupying certain localities with powers, although he did not have them, which he has remitted that they robbed, murdered, burned, and committed all kinds of violence with perfect impunity.
