A Free Ride for our Colored Folks. Our colored people had made arrangements to hold a 4th of July excursion at Seguin, but recently a division has occurred.

The discussion of this matter at a recent meeting brought up a question on which our colored population are very tender.

They declare they were the most ardent supporters of the railroad proposition when it was before the people, that if they did not vote early and often, they did work early and late, and in all the excursions and free "blow-outs" they have been overlooked.

They felt the slight, and determined to ask of the railway magnates a free train to carry them to Seguin on the 4th. A committee appointed waited on Mayor French yesterday, and got him to lay the matter before Capt. Gibbs.
