Callender points out that an acre of water has a "carrying capacity", just as an acre of grazing land does. The amount of food proing seventeen months in the army. duced in the water will depend up-He formerly was principal and on the fertility of the land over which the water flows. Fertile land means a fertile pond of water.

Here are Callender's recommendations for fertilizing fish ponds.

As first choice, he suggests using a mixture of 400 pounds of cottonseed or soybean meal and 200 phate to the surface acre of water for one year. Broadcast half of this ponents 711, which is an average amount over the pond early in the spring, and apply the rest in 100pound applications at four to six week interavls.

Callender's second choice is 500 Apply half of this early in the spring and follow with 100-pound applications at three or four week intervals until the amount for the year is broadcast in the pond.

Horse and cow manure also may be used as fishpond fertilizer. Apply 500 pounds to the acre at monthly applications, using two to three tons a season.

\$706.40 RAISED IN RED CROSS DRIVE IN STERLING COUNTY



> Bacillary dysentery, caused by plant-life germ. is not as serious or as prolonged as amebic dysen- right here at the News-Record. tery, caused by animal-life germ, but is more easily spread. Towels, eating utensils, and food handled by a person with bacillary dysentery or the germ which causes it may spread it to others. Within a day it makes itself known by cramping of the intestines, fever. and watery bowel movements.

Bacillary dysentery can usually be controlled by proper treatment within one to four days without any after-effects outside of an occasional attack of arthritis.

Amebic dysentery, on the other hand, doesn't usually make you suddenly sick; it starts off with minor cramps in the abdomen, alternate periods of loose bowels and constipation, and slight fever if any; but there is usually some weight loss and a general feeling of illness along with flecks of blood

It may affect other organs of the body, especially the liver ,and may become quite serious.





Chocolate Birds Nests

1 package (8 squares) candy-making chocolate; 1 cup roasted peanuts, skinned; 1 cup coconut, toasted; 1/2 cup coconut, untoasted; Jelly Beans.

Heat chocolate over boiling water until partly melted; then remove from boiling water and stir rapidly until entirely melted. Add nuts and toasted coconut; stir until peanuts and coconut are completely coated with chocolate. Drop from tablespoon on waxed paper. Shape with 2 teaspoons to form nests. Cool until firm. Fill nests with plain coconut and jelly beans. Makes 14 nests.

Note: If desired, drop by teaspoon on waxed paper. Makes 21/2 dozen clusters.
