was more than 2.100 above the figure the same date last year, and gave additional strength to the
theory that the cattle run is starting early this year.
Suspicion that this would be the case developed some weeks ago and has been growing steadily. A num-
ber of factors are involved. In many sections of the Eastern third of Texas the winter and spring
season has provided ample pasture. season has provided ample pasture.
This is especially true in the clover growing areas.
Many cattle producers in these areas bought low cost cows last summer and fail, and at this writ-
ing have a very good profit made in them. Many cases of "doubled money" are heard, and these stock-
men are inclined to sell before the hot weather brings excessive runs
