





The two men feature a variety of balancing and acrobat- 'NEUMONIA ic routines as well as object juggling. Starting with the demonstration of the fundamentals of juggling, balancing and tumbling this team progresses to perform some of the most difficult juggling of hoops. balls, clubs and Roman battle axes. But not only do they juggle and pass various objects from partner to partner while standing upright. they also juggle while upside down in a free head balance, with both their hands and feet. 




