security office three months before retirement, there are
some records you'll need to
take. The best way to find out what you whould to fine is
to phone ahead. In addition to to phone ahead. In addition to

wife is 62 and wants to apply
for benefits also, she'll need a record of her age. If you
call the social security office
before youl pay the before you pay the pre-retire

there's some record you don't have, they can usually help
you get it. Helping people with retirement claims is their bus-
