

## **Peripatetic Continent**

Waters unexpectedly teeming tlingly rich in fish; within 45 min-ith fish . . . giant submarine can-utes, a trawler made the "excepwith fish . . . giant submarine canyons and mountains . . . ancient traces of a "drifting" subcontinent. These are some of the preliminary findings reported by scientists of the Indian Ocean Expedition sponsored by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNES-

Since the cooperative venture was launched in 1959, some 30 research vessels from the United States and 23 other countries have crisscrossed the third largest and least-explored ocean.

It will take years to evaluate all the data collected. However, one American scientist reported that the Arabian Sea proved star- 100 million years ago.


