institution of higher learning? A.--Yes, if its credits are ac ceptable toward granting of baccalaureate degree by a col-
lege, university, or similar inlege, universty, or similar in stitution. Q.--How long can a person uate college student?
A.--He can be deferred in
Class II-S until he completes the requirements for his baccalaureate degree (if completed
within the normal and fied time), until he fails to pursue satisfatarily a full-time
course of instruction, or until he reaches age 24 , whichever occurs first.
Q.--Will Q.-.Will men who become
fathers after the new Sele finers artier the new Selec-
tive Service law became effective (June 30, 1967) be deferred in Class III-A?
A.--Every case will have to be consider
