Social Security Tips CHECK YOUR SOCIAL 1971-72 SECURITY RECORD Time "How do I know my work 5:00 under social security is being 5:00 credited to my record, and how do I find out about it? 5:00 This is one of the questions most frequently asked," says J. M. Talbot, social security man-5:00 ager. 5:00 In explaining the process in-5:00 volved in reporting social sec-5:00 curity, Mr. Talbot said, -'When 5:00 you work for wages, your em-5:00 ployer deducts social security 5:00 tax from your paycheck each 5:00 pay day. At the end of each 5:00 calendar quarter, he submits 5:00 your name and number with 5:00 payment for these taxes to 5:00 Internal Revenue. Internal Revenue forwards copies to T-There

social security's main office in Baltimore, Maryland. Your wages are then posted to your record. The same process is followed for a self-employed person except that his earnings are recorded yearly."

Mr. Talbot states that the possibility of an error being made in the process does exist. He recommends that you request a statement of your earnings at least every three vears.

All you have to do to secure the statement is to send a post card request available at your social security office to Baltimore, Maryland. If the reply you receive is incorrect in any way, contact the Social Security Office at 3000 West Harris Avenue (P. O. Box 3808) in San Angelo, Texas, or see the representative when he is in your area.

Each calendar quarter, the Social Security Administration receives employer reports of earnings showing incorrect social security numbers of employees, according to J.M. Talbot, social security manager. These incorrect reports, in many cases, happen when
