## Many people think living on a budget is like going on a starvation diet.

 a starvation diet.But a budget is simply a
financial plan that enables finanilias to achieve financial
fame security and reach their
goals, says home economist
Nancy Granovsky. "Actually, a budget is more like a
road map for charting where road map for charting where
you want to go than a spen-
ding diet", she adds. you want to go than a spe
ding diet,", she adds.
According to Gransvsky, specialist in family resource management for the Texas
A\&M University AgricultuA\&M University Agricultu-
ral Extension Service, fami-
lies can develop a livable, lies can develop a livable,
non-constricting budget by non-constricting budget
following these steps:
First, examine past ding patterns for at Ieast
two to six months. Use old two to six months. Use old
receipts, check-stubs or or receipts, check-stubs or
other records to show where
the money has gone and the money has gone and
how much has come in dur-
ing the same period. Or, ing the same period. Or,
keep close records for two to three months.
Then determine what percentage of spendable in-
come has gone for major come has gone for major
categories such as housing,
utilities,
transportation, utilities, transportation,
non-mortgage credit payments, health care, food and
cothing. If more than 25
percent. goes for "miscellaneous," you will need to
keep better records for a while ein order to track your
spending, says the speciaspending, says
list.
Now you are ready to proNow you are ready to pro-
ject ahead, using your past
financial records as a guide. financial records as a guide.
Estimate total spending
during the during the budget period,
being sure to include exbeing sure to include ex-
penses like insurance pay-
ments that come due only ments that come due only
occasionally. On a monthly budget, estimate these occ-
asional costs at $1 / 12$ of the annual cost so you will not be caught short when pay-
