Some curious experiments have been made in England for the purpose of demonstrating the value of infantry as opposed to artillery. The result was not such as was anticipated. A half battery of artillery was represented by three logs of wood, painted black, each supported by a couple of trestles. The guns were at full intervals and placed on a shelf of the target butt, about iwalva fact above the level of the range. In the rear of each gun, at a distance of some four yards, were placed, resting on a slightly inclined position against the target butt, a brown blanket on a frame eight feet square.
