Report of the Proceedings Had at Lockhart.

The Presbytery of West Texas met at Lockhart on Thursday, April 2nd, at eight o'clock p. m. It was opened with a sermon by the retiring moderator, Rev. J. H. Zivley.

Rev. William Hall, of Comstock, was elected moderator and Rev. George Wadell, of San Saba, clerk. All the ministers belonging to the body were present.

The book of church orders, sent down by the general assembly for a final vote, was read by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays.

Rev. I. H. Zivley was elected ministerial commissioner to the general assembly, and Rev. William Hall, his alternate.

Dr. McLeary was elected the commissioner on the eldership, and Hon. J. F. Miller, of Comstock, his alternate.

A motion was made to abolish the next meeting of the Presbytery, after an animated debate the motion was lost, and the meeting adjourned to meet next fall in the Orange Church, near Ft. Hancock.

Mr. Z. B. Graves, a brother of Dr. Graves of this city, was licensed as a probationer of the gospel ministry. His name, he was examined on the arts and sciences, natural and moral philosophy, natural and revealed theology, church history and government, the scriptures, Latin and Greek.
