BELATING TO REDEMPTION OF BONDS.

Washington, April 28.—The treasury department is advised that the instructions in a circular of April 18th, reserving refunding captificates for sale in sums not to exceed \$100, are being evaded for speculative purposes, and announces that where such evasion is manifest, or where any one person calms more than \$100 either for himself or others, the certificates will be refused, and the authority of any designated depository who fails to enforce the regulations will not be allowed on sales made by him. Owing to the great pressure on the department in the issue of four per cents already subscribed for and the redemption of the called 5-20 and 10-40 honds, the conversion of funding certificates into bonds will necessarily be post-posed till on or after July first.

Washington, April 28.—The house committee on agriculture to-day agreed to report to the house for printing and recommittal a bill which has been partially agreed on, making it a misclemennor for common carriers to transport eattle affected with plearopneumonia, or other contagious diseases. After establishing a penalty for such action, the bill directs the commission of agriculture to appoint an agent at important points along the lines of railroads, whose duty it shall be to examine eattle being transported, and authorize the secretary of the treasury to designate agents at shipping ports, who shall set in conjunction with the custom officers in examining all eattle imported or exported.

Baid quarantine to extend to all vessels sailing from or touching at any port or coast south of north latitude 28 degrees. I hereby further direct health officers at the respective ports, as soon as they are reliably informed of the existence of infectious or contagious disease at any other port, city or town not herein specially included to declare all vessels arriving from such places subject to quarantine and to all the regulations istabilished for the enforcement of the same. Vessels sailing from or touching at any port or coast south of north latitude 25 degrees, and entering any port on the coast of Texas during the continuance of quarantine if free Vessels sailing from or touching at any port or coast south of north latitude 25 degrees, and entering any port on the coast of Texas during the continuance of quarantine if free from disease may be disinfected and relieved from detention, or detained for a term that will make twenty days from date of departure from said infected port or district, at the discretion of the health officer. Health officers are directed to provide and enforce such regulations as will prevent all communication with vessels in quarantine; and also to provide for the thorough disinfection of all vessels on which there has been any contagious or infectious disease, before they are allowed to leave quarantine; all expenses necessary
