People who have got their expenses down to hard pan in satisfy the new condition of things might as well turn their attention for a moment to the fact that extravagance in public places is still flourishing. Mr. Geo. C. Gorbain, late secretary of the United States senate, has recently presented the expense account of that gill-edge body for the eight months ended on March 4 last. It shows that the senate's expenses for eight months aggregated \$632,836.96, a rate of about \$1,000,000 a year. It is truthfully said that this is the most expensive legislative body in the world for its size. Some of the items of account are open to the gravest suspicion, stationery for senators costs \$1,000 a month; new furniture and repairing absorbed \$8,000 and over; the Teller committee, appointed under the Bhaine resolution, and had an existence of less than three months, cost over \$18,000 and the committee to reorganise the army, which produced a bill that hardly any one wants passed, took between \$5000 and \$6000. The salaries of the officers of the senate and committee clerks reached the senate and leave money over. The whole people are interested in a matter of such importance as this.
