The New York Shipping List says that the immense cotton crop of last year and the present year depresses the theory that was held in the south and to a limited extent in the north, prior to the civil war, that cotton could not be raised with free labor. During the decade preceding the war—the last ten years of slavery—the cotton crop of the south was in round numbers 25,000,000 bales. During the last ten years, including 1879, the crop was \$3,000,000,000, valued at \$3,000,000,000, and the present year is estimated at \$3,000,000,000. The United States now raises nearly half the cotton grown in the world, yet each year's crop for the whole world could be grown, says Mr. Edward Atkinson, of Boston, one of the highest authorities on cotton statistics, on a tenth of the soil in the United States, or on the good lands of any other cotton-growing state, without oversteering them.

A visitor to the collector of customs in Alaska, hitherto unprinted, says the state of things there is as bad and disgraceful as can be imagined. Every other house is an Indian distillery. 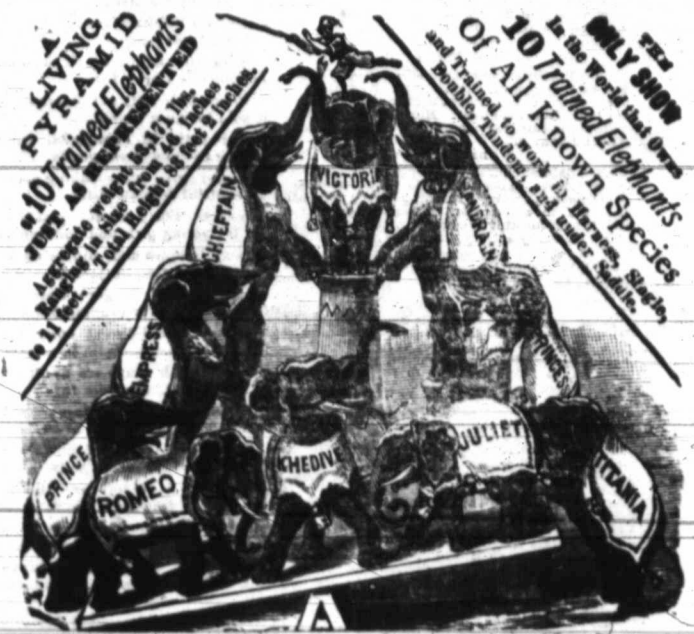
