Appointments by the Governor—Numerous Bills Favorably Reported. Prohibition Bill Passed to Third Reading in the House—Senate and House Agree to Adjourn on April 1st.

Special Dispatch to the Daily Express. Austin, March 12.—The governor, from the program making the following appointments, were confirmed: R. Y. Bell, of Cook county, to be district attorney of the tenth district; J. P. Foster, of Gonzales county, to be district attorney of the sixth district; and C. K. Bell, of Hamilton county, to be district attorney of the thirteenth district.

Committee on judicial districts reported favorably on house bills presenting terms of holding district courts in Gonzales and Kaufman counties and the 14th district.

Committee on state affairs reported unfavorably on bill amending the charter of the city of Dallas.

Committee on constitutional amendments reported favorably on senate joint resolution to extend the term of state senators to six years and representatives to four years.

Bill concerning factors and commission merchants regarding the fees of sheriffs, constables and county judges in certain cases, passed.

Bill amending the code relative to fees of sheriffs and constables for jury cases passed to third reading.

Bill amending the code relative to the condemnation of land in cities, and providing for the compensation for the same, passed.

Bill amending the act requiring persons owning the title of real estate, to pay an annual rent therefor, passed.

Bill for the protection of stock-holders in stock companies and providing for the surrender of stock in certain cases, was indefinitely postponed.

A message from the house announced that the house had amended the senate resolution to sit on the 22nd, by extending the time to April 1st next. This resolution was immediately taken up but a lengthy discussion ensued thereon. It was finally passed.
