came into the possession of Kaufman & Bunge until sold; that under these circumstances he received the cotton on board said barge, and gave her bill of lading therefor, to deliver the same to Melly, Furge & Co., at Liverpool, England, all of which, he claimed, was according to the usage and custom of merchants, and in due course of trade. The jury found for plaintiff in the sum of \$1,850.10 and judgment was rendered accordingly.

The third suit, Adams & Lobit vs. H. Seigerson & Co., involves the right of property under the statute. James Artzke, a commission merchant, had 130 bales of cotton, the property in controversy, stored in the warehouse of the defendant, on said barge, and was in the possession of Adams & Lobit, bankers, who had loaned him \$6,118.25 on the cotton. Artzke, giving them an order for the delivery of the cotton to the big barge, then loading for Liverpool. The order was accepted and bill of lading executed in usual form. Artzke had an account with H. Seigerson & Co., bankers, and appellees in this case, and was indebted to them, on open account, in the sum of about \$6,500. From this debt Seigerson & Co., recovered judgment against Artzke. Seigerson & Co., met out a writ of attachment on said barge against Artzke, which was levied on the cotton in controversy in the Taylor press on Taylor's order, giving them the cotton, and the bill of lading, and the order for the delivery of the cotton to the big barge, and Adams & Lobit said the cotton, and filed their claim and bond. The issue was whether the property levied on under the writ of attachment was subject to the writ. The case was tried by the court, a jury being waived, and judgment was rendered in favor of Seigerson & Co., the attaching creditors. Motion for new trial was overruled. Adams & Lobit, claimants, gave notice of appeal, and presented their appeal to this court.
