A NATIONAL CIVIL-SERVICE CONFERENCE has been in session at Newport, R. I., among those present being George William Curtis, Carl Schurz, and Richard H. Dana, Jr. Mr. Curtis thought the first necessity was the passage of the Pendleton bill by congress, and another important matter the abolition of political assessments. A resolution was passed opposing assessments by members of congress, as well as interference by members of congress with the exercise of the appointing power.

The bureau of statistics has submitted to the secretary of the treasury a statement of the exports of petroleum for the month of June and for the year ending June 30, 1881. Total exports for June, 64,968,601 gallons valued at \$3,563,366, against 31,221,391 gallons, valued at \$2,235,912. For the year, 597,660,167 gallons, worth \$40,218,106, against 423,964,600 gallons, worth \$30,218,625. This petroleum business is "old oil" for the Americans.

The New York Tribune gives a historical review of the English parliamentary oath and the modifications that have been made in it from time to time. The U. S. superior inspector of steam vessels reports that during the fiscal year there were 238 lives lost of passengers and crews upon merchant steam vessels of the United States. Compared with the previous year there has been an increase in the number of lives lost of 88 persons. There has also been a decrease, however, of 41 lives by fire, 26 by collisions and two by other causes. Many cases reported as accidental drowning are thought to be hidden suicides. During the year it is estimated that upwards of a quarter of a million of passengers were carried.

The new commissioner of agriculture has taken up the matter of sinking experimental arroyos in the arid region east of the Rocky mountains, and appointed a scientific commission to select the sites and direct the work. The area which it is proposed to explore extends from the northern boundary of the United States to the Rio Grande, comprising portions of Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, Montana, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico and Texas. The gentlemen selected for this task are Prof. William C. Cresswell, Col. and Prof. Anghy, of Lincoln, Neb., and their report is to be made by January 1, 1882.

The pardoning power in Pennsylvania is used, under the new constitution, in a board of pardons.
