statutes. The first offense is the illegal sales of options for the future delivery of grain and other commodities. The fact that property is sold to be delivered at a future day does not make the contract illegal or that it is not at the time possessed or owned by the seller, or that the time of its delivery is left (within the fixed limits) optional with the buyer or the seller, though in one sense any such sale of an option is apparently within the statute. What makes it a gambling contract is the intent of the parties that there shall not be a delivery of the commodity sold, but a payment of the differences by the party losing upon the rise or fall in the market. 
