NATIONAL TARIFF CONVENTION, THE LAST DAY'S SESSION.

Measures adopted to restore the supremacy of our merchant marine on the high seas. New York, December 1.—In the tariff convention at the close, the five-minute speeches of delegates representing various industries were resumed at the evening session. John Bosch addressed the convention on ship-building and the rank of our marine to-day and its rank in the world's commerce. At the conclusion of Bosch's address, memorials and resolutions were presented by the committee on resolutions. That relating to the abolition of the tax on whiskey and tobacco was, after some debate, stricken out. As adopted it declares in favor of the policy of protective duties, and an intelligent revision of the tariff laws will give full and harmonious effect to the protective policies of the civil commission appointed by congress, and pending the deliberations of the convention districts, and destructive assaults upon protective duties on special industries are not permitted. The resolutions also demand immediate action by congress on the tariff laws, and ask for the prompt revision of the same. The convention then adjourned sine die.
