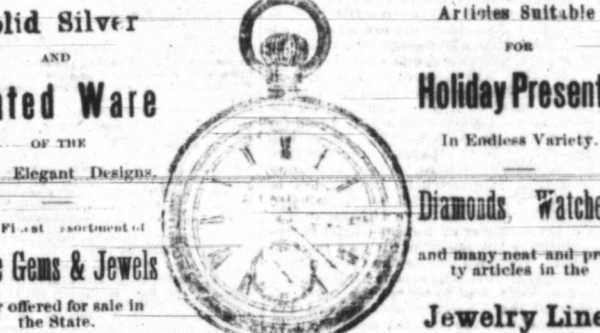
THE MURDER OF A MAN BY THE NAME OF HENRY.
