## Here's What the Building Supply News of Chicago, Ill., Says About Building

Ever since October 9 and the famous "Building Priorities" regulation, the building industry has been kept in almost constant turmoil by repeated threats of "stop orders."

HERE IS WHAT THE ORDER. SAYS:
No Civilian Building of Any Kind Will Be Permitted Except:

1. Residential construction, including farm home, costing less than $\$ 500$ on any one residence in any 12 month period
2. Maintenance and repairs.
3. Farm production buildings (costing $\$ 1,000$ or less per structure).
4. All other civilian construction (commercial, industrial, recreational, etc.) costing $\$ 5,000$ or less.
5. Residential buildings desroyed by fire, earthquake, tornado, enemy action, etc., may be rebuilt.
6. Buildings under construction may, at present, be completed.
7. Any kind of civilian building for which a real need can be shown. A permit will be issued in that case.
