Sudan, Earth tie in December sales tax race

Sudan and Earth ended the year with a tie, as both communities showed a 22.24 percent increase in their sales tax disbursement for November when compared to the same period in 2008.

However, the overall prize increase in sales tax revenue for the year to date goes to Sudan, which logged an increase of 3.88 percent. In this race, Earth's increase was 2.26 percent, while the local favorite — Muleshoe, took a 14.78 percent drop in its November disbursement, and a 2.26 percent drop in its yearto-date totals.
