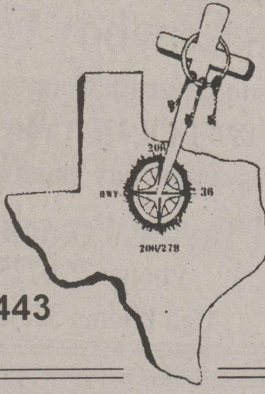

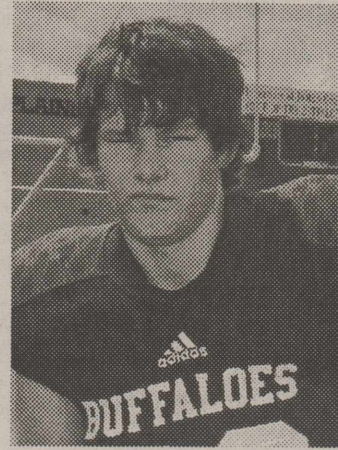

Four other Buffaloes were named Honorable Mention - Defense.

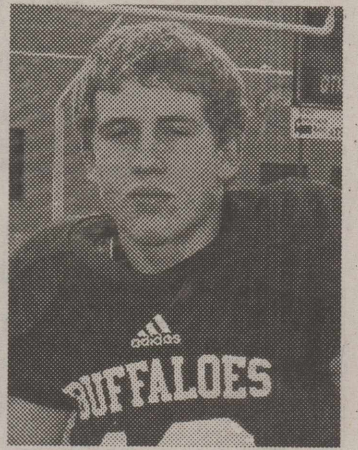

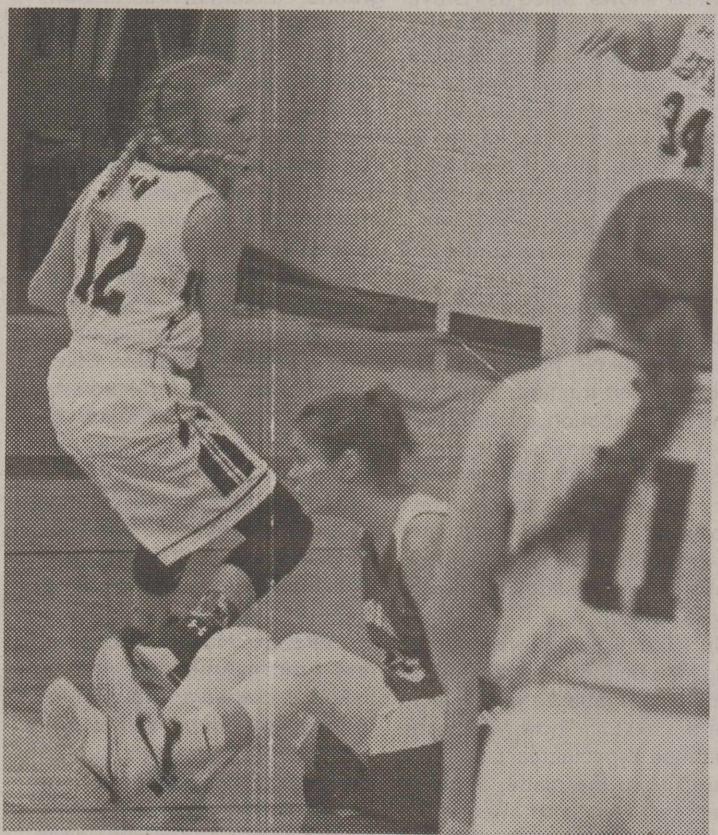
Lady Buffs Beat the Lady Wildcats 60-38

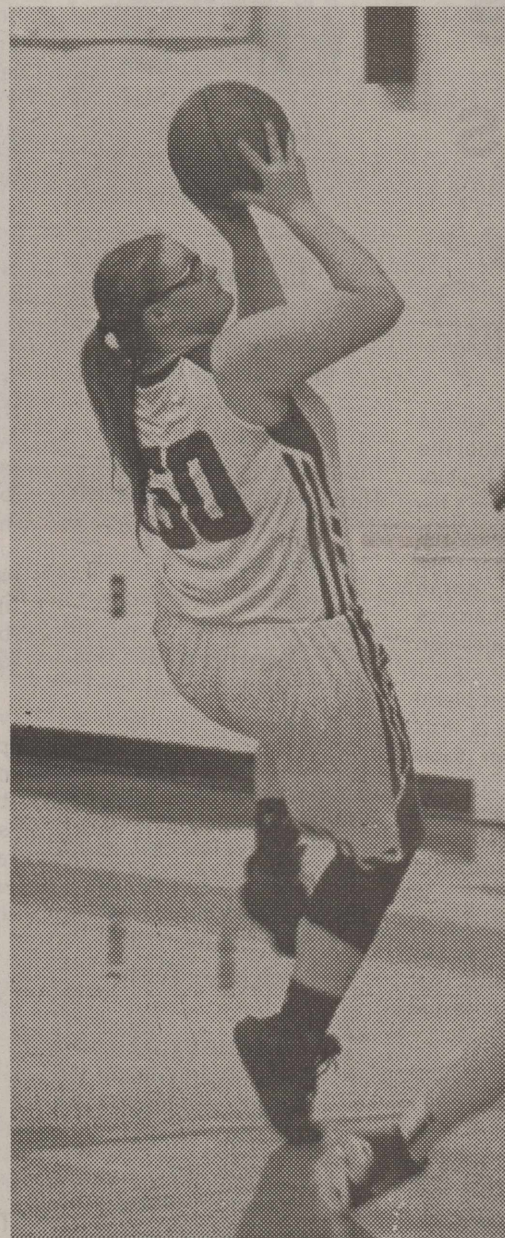

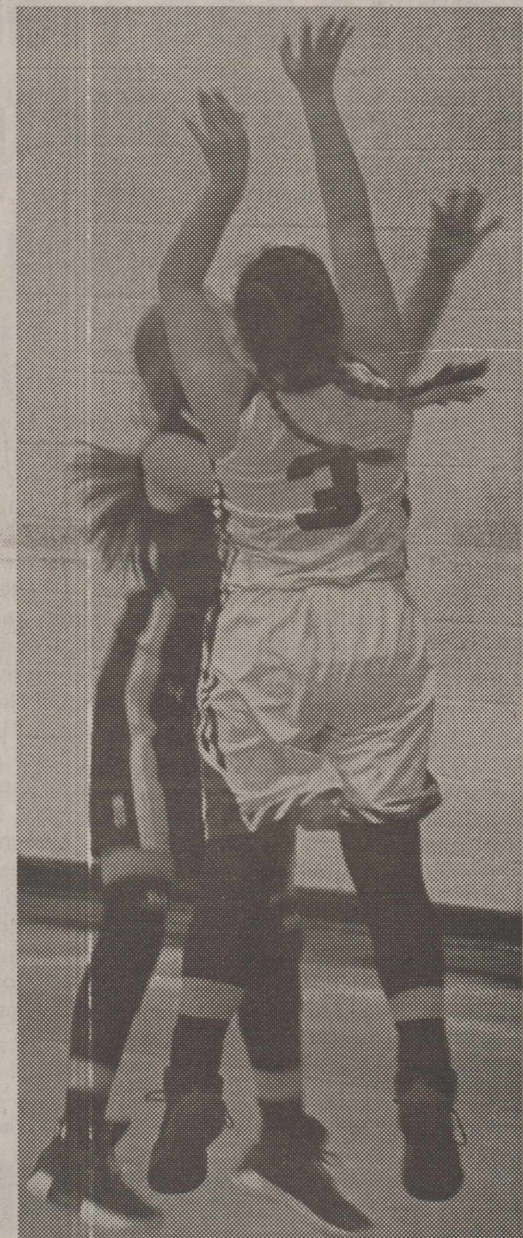
On Saturday, the Girls will play Blanket at 9 a.m., followed by the Boys vs. Blanket at 10 a.m.

Cross Plains Girls and Boys return to the court at 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. to play against Zephyr.



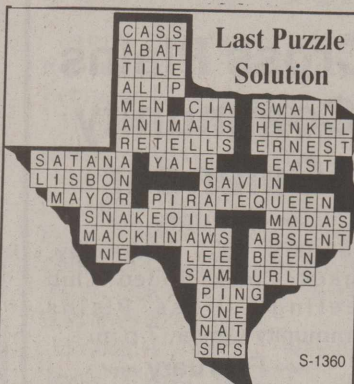

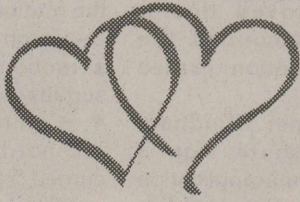
Teri and Dee, the owners of Patsy's Flowers and Gifts, have answered the challenge by planning a coffee tasting at their shop.

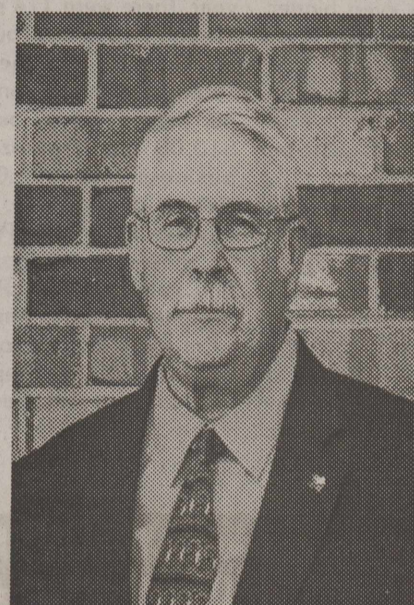

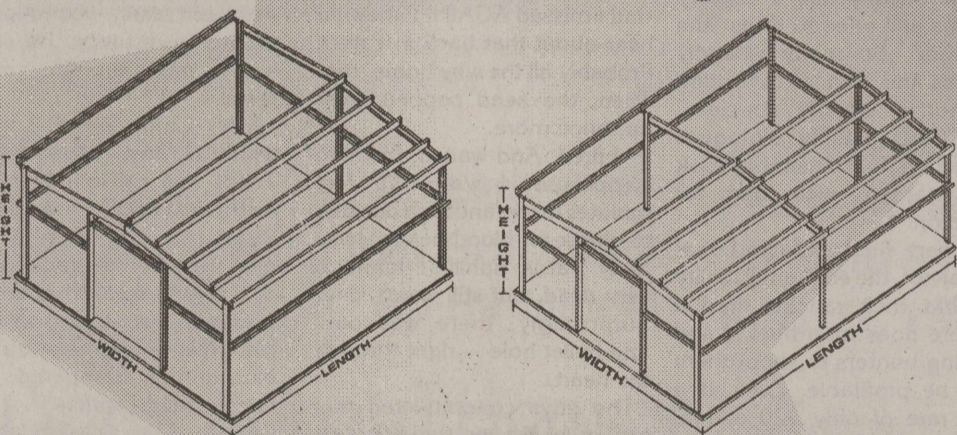

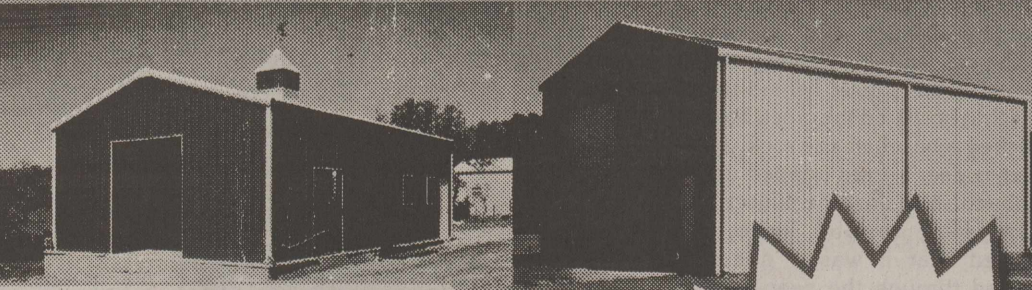
