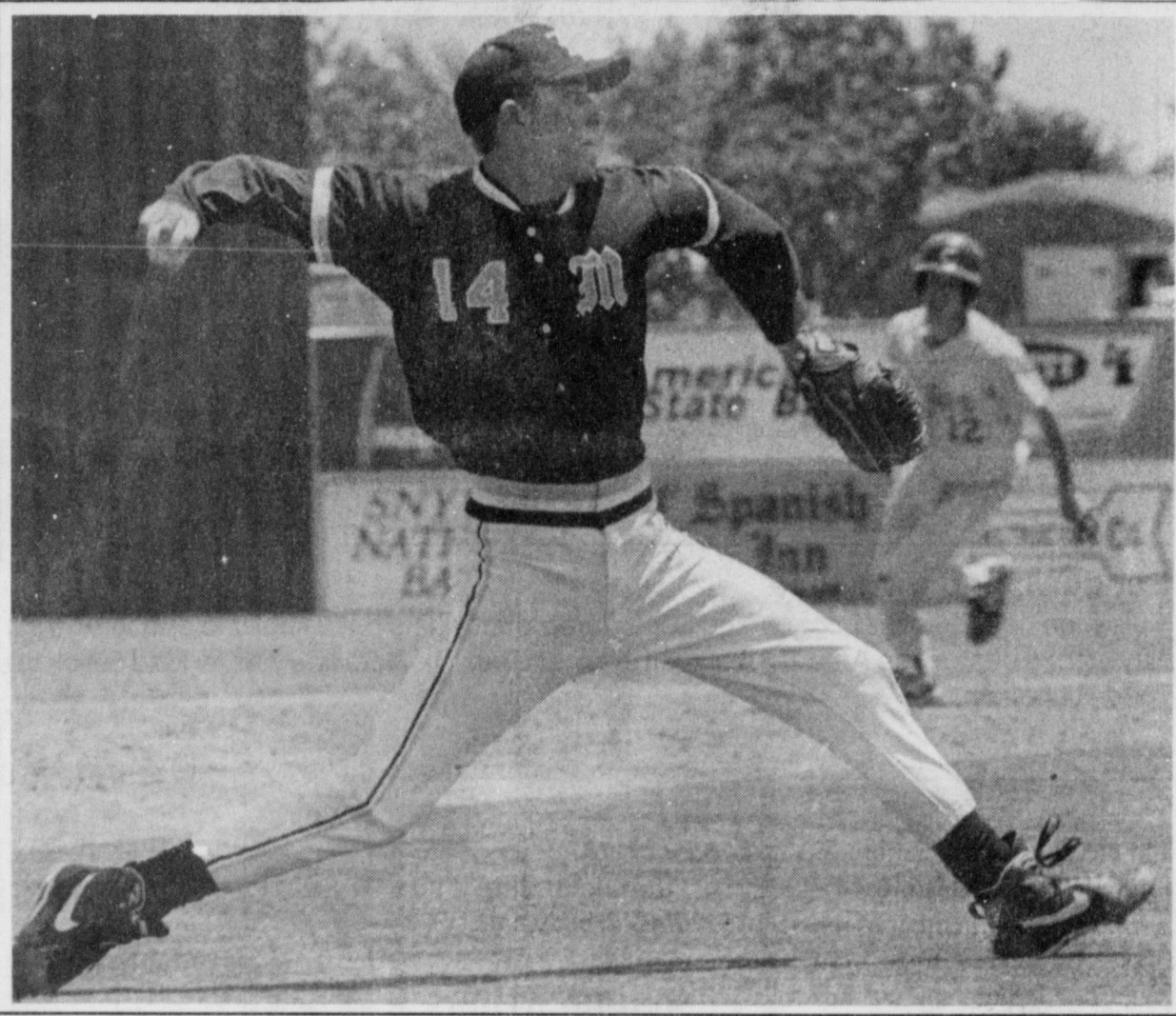
Cowboy Camp planned Sunday

Recent rains end the county wide drought

Bailey county received a much needed rain this past week with amounts varying over the county. Following several months of drought conditions in the Muleshoe area, this week's rains brought the month's total to two inches for the city.

In Muleshoe, Monday night's shower dropped only .10 of an inch, but Sunday night a .7 mark was recorded by the federal gauge operated by J.K. Adams on the south edge of town.

Southern Bailey county re-

ported .4 of rain on Friday and .8 on Sunday. Some pea-size hail was reported in Sunday's storm, but according to Pat Dupler at the Bailey Gin, no serious damage was done. Another .4 of rain fell again in southern Bailey on Monday night.

North of Muleshoe the rain was heavier, but hail took some cotton and farmers will be replanting. Scott Branscum reported 2.5 inches of rain since Friday for the Lazbuddie area.

Rains are expected to continue throughout the week.

Elizabeth Watson named 1995 Heart Association regional volunteer of year

Elizabeth Bailey Watson of Muleshoe, who has the distinction of having a junior high school named in her honor, has received the American Heart Association's regional volunteer of the year award for 1995.

At the annual meeting of the Bailey County branch of the AHA on May 23, Watson was presented a plaque recognizing her 20 years of service to the association. The regional award represents volunteers

in a 15-county area of Texas.

Watson has held the position of president of the association three times (in 1994-95, 1993-94 and 1980-81) as well as other offices. She has served on the board of the Bailey County branch of the AHA for ten years.

Her volunteer activities for the association have included distributing materials about eating right to students in area schools.

Watson said the Bailey County branch sponsors a jump-athon every other year in which students jump rope to earn funds for the American Heart Association.

She said students helped raise approximately \$3,500 at the last event. As a volunteer, Watson also collects pledges not to smoke from area high school students.

Muleshoe bats silent in 5-0 loss to Graham Mules end season 20-7 as district, bi-district champs

SNYDER — When it came down to it, the outcome of last Saturday's Area 1-3A playoff battle between the Muleshoe Mules and the Graham Steers came down to one thing — hitting.

While both teams pitched and fielded well in the contest, it was the Steers who came up with the key hits and advanced with a 5-0 victory at Moffett Field.

Muleshoe starter Andy Perez scattered eight hits and his teammates turned a pair of double plays behind him in key situations, including one with the bases loaded and no outs in the fourth that prevented Graham from scoring.

But at the plate, the Mules struggled. Graham starter Ryan Dollar was never overpower-

ing, just steady, as the Mules managed just four hits and never got a runner past second base. Perez had two of the Mules four hits, both singles, while John Embry added a double and Robert Jaime and single.

Dollar struck out just four, but didn't walk a single batter. He kept the Mules off balance with a regular diet of fastballs and curves. The Mules popped up and grounded out at a regular pace.

Dollar was the key for Graham at the plate and on the bases as well. He went 3-for-3 on the day with two singles and a double, drove in two runs, scored two runs and stole two bases.

Saving tailwater waste

Many High Plains producers are busy applying last-minute pre-plant irrigations to wet the soil profile for 1995 planting. Unfortunately, some of this ground water is escaping from fields as tailwater, and that is against both State Law and High Plains Underground Water Conversation District No. 1 rules.

Water District rules define tailwater as "ground water pumped for irrigation that escapes...onto land other than that of the owner of the well unless permission has been

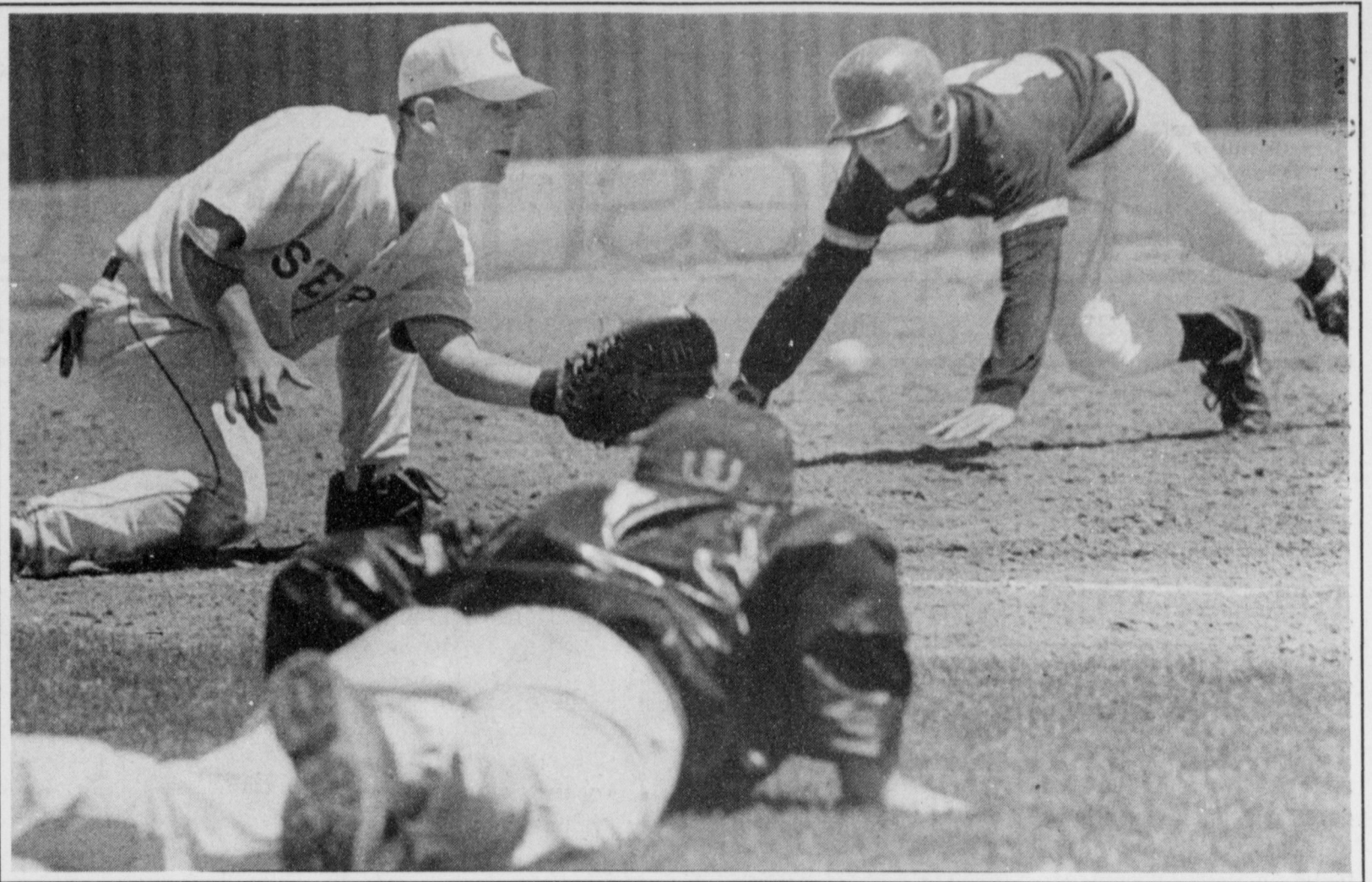
recover. Dollar struck out the final two Mules to end the inning unscathed.

and the Texas Association for Improvement of Reading.

She also is a member of the First Baptist Church in Muleshoe, where she teaches an adult Sunday school class.

Muleshoe Junior High School was renamed Watson Junior High in her honor, and she was named Muleshoe's Citizen of the Year in 1980.

granted by the occupant of the land receiving the discharge.

"This permission must be in the form of an agreement signed between the parties on a form acceptable to the Water District. Potential parties to such an agreement are warned that it may obligate the provider to provide a specified supply of water into perpetuity and/or the recipient to accept runoff in whatever quantities at whatever time the provider chooses. Provisions of any agreement entered into must comply with Rule 1(h)(5)."

Rule 1(h)(5) defines water waste as "Wilfully or negligently causing, suffering, or permitting underground water to escape into any river, creek, natural watercourse, depression, lake, reservoir, drain, sewer, highway, road or road ditch, or onto land other than the owner of the well."

When a tailwater report is received, Water District personnel investigate the water waste and document it with written memorandums and photographs. In addition, they contact the landowners and/or operators and ask these parties to stop the water waste.

"We prefer to work with farmer and address the problem; and in most cases, that works," says Ken Carve, High Plains Water District Assistant Manager. "If the waste doesn't stop, then we have no choice but to seek an injunction from

Under an injunction, continued tailwater waste is considered Contempt of Court and carries a maximum penalty of a \$500 fine and/or a six-month jail sentence per occurrence.

If violations continue under the injunction, the District Court may also order the County Sheriff to padlock the water well to prevent further waste.

Violators can also be held liable for damages resulting from their water waste, such as accidents on flooded roadways, property damages, or crop damage.

Tailwater control methods include reducing row lengths, terracing, and installing borders at the end of the field.

Surge irrigation systems, which alternate water flow between two sets of furrows in timed cycles, can be set to

automatically cut back irrigation set times at the time the water is expected to reach the end of the field. Use of these valves has proven to be very effective in tailwater management.

Tailwater return pits or modified playas have been used in the past to collect the runoff water. Water collected in the pits can be pumped to irrigate crops for about one-fifth of the cost of pumping ground water to the land surface from irrigation wells.

Use of a LEPA center pivot sprinkler system is a good tailwater management practice, because the movement speed of the center pivot can be adjusted to match the water application rate to the soil infiltration rate. Use of furrow dikes under the pivot to collect the water and hold it in place can also increase application efficiency.

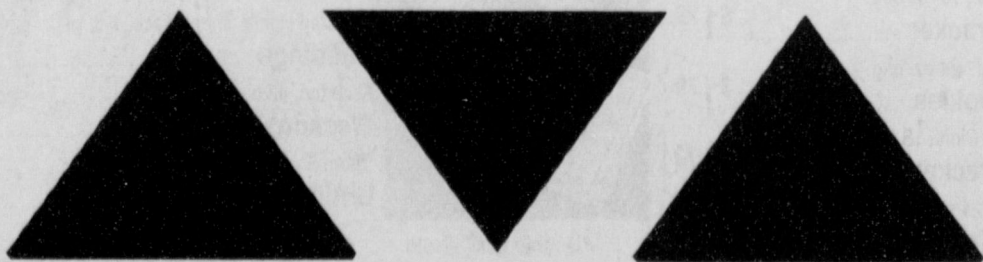

Lazbuddie Elementary School recently participated in the 1995 Midwest News Bowl.

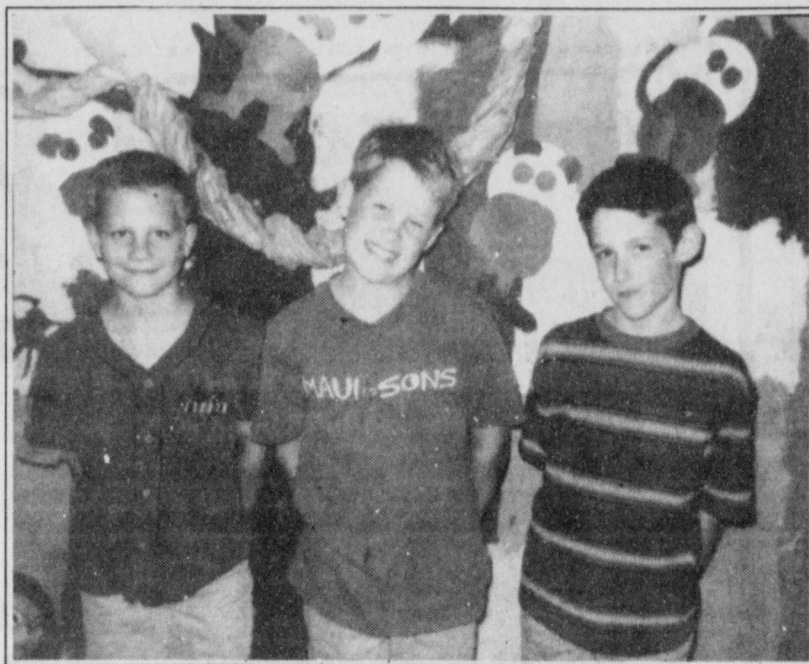
The News Bowl is a current events knowledge competition open to fourth through eighth graders in 15 midwest states.



A loan broker should not be

confused with either mortgage brokers, who arrange real estate loans, or money lenders, which include such entities as banks, savings and loans and credit unions.

Loan brokers cannot make real estate loans and do not lend money directly to borrowers. Advance fee loan brokers usually communicate their services through newspaper advertising in the "money to loan" columns or broadcast over television or radio. BBBs across the country identify new advance fee loan companies almost daily.

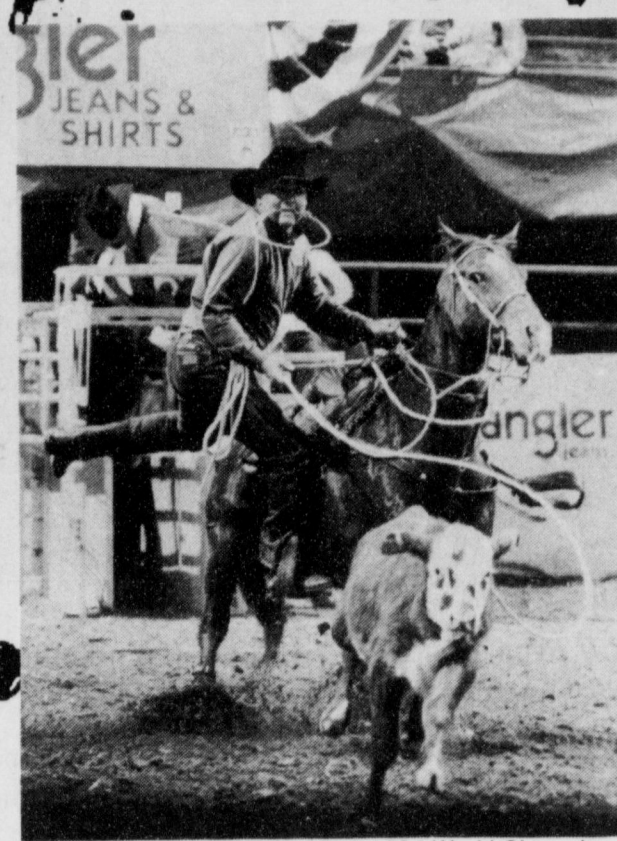
A loan broker may or may not require an advance fee before performing services. Some brokers may guarantee financing, but since brokers themselves do not lend money, they really cannot guarantee that any given lending source will come through with funds for the applicant.

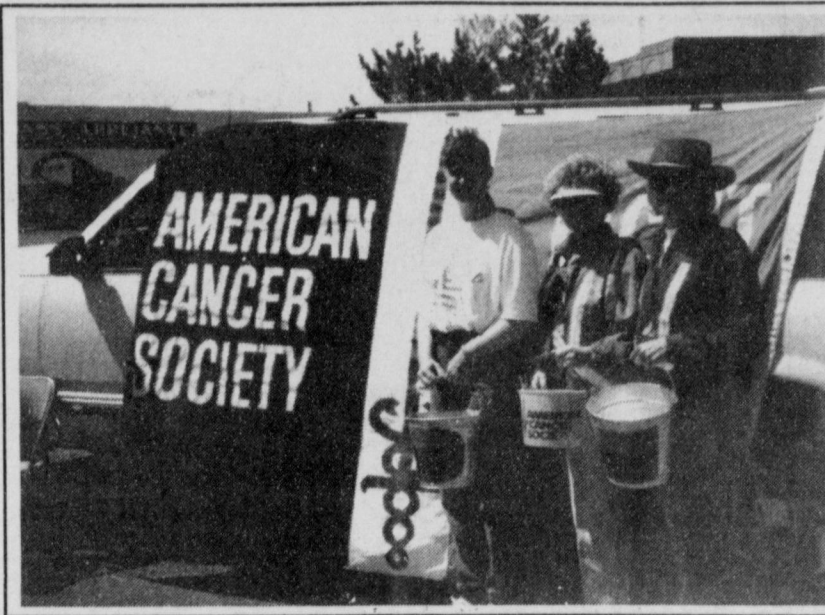



Additionally, the regional winner's entries will be reproduced along with the other regional winner's artwork, on book covers to be distributed to area schools throughout the fourteen county region this August.

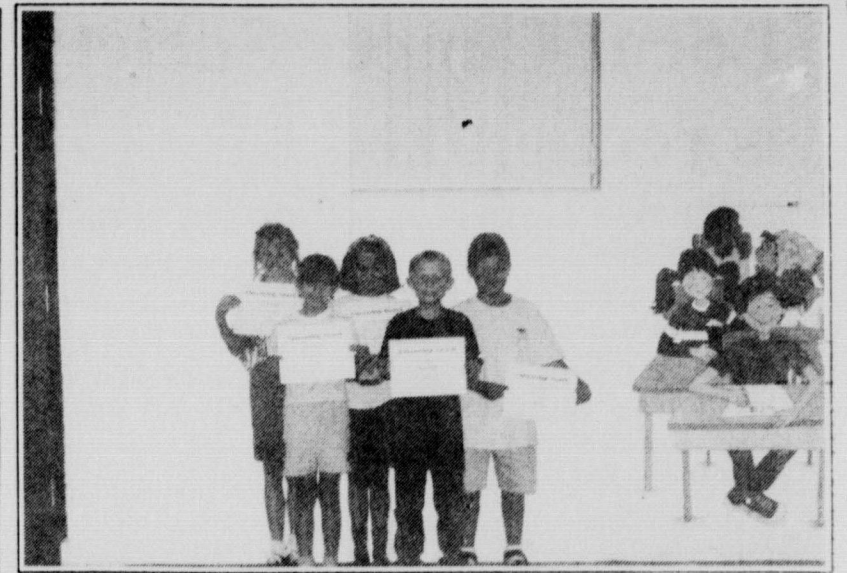

American method demonstrated in Australia



A medical doctor friend of mine was recounting his experiences in Africa as a volunteer for a church missionary program. He said it was very satisfying for the soul but his biggest problem was communicating with the patients. He gave me an odd look and said it gave him a begrudging respect for veterinarians.

Four years ago I made a trip to Australia. Grand folks, hospitable and definitely livestock people. However, it did take me several days to get used to the language. It's like you're talkin' Spanish to an Italian... they sound so much alike, you actually think you're communicating!

The only thing I really learned to say in Australian was ketchup. But they call it T'maw-toe-sawz.

It didn't stop me from makin' friends. I spent a week each with a couple of bush country veterinarians. On the day they planned to pass me from one to the other we made the trip from Barraba to Quirindi.

The three of us found much in common, as three ol' cow vets would. We spent the afternoon at an Angus field day.

That evening my hosts had planned a big formal supper. On our way home a call came over the two-way.

"Can you attend a kawving?" It squawked.

"A carving?" I asked. "Yes, a kawving."

It was getting dark as we climbed out of the car at a little farm. The wife said her husband was detained at the pub but the heifer was in the crush.

Said heifer was smallish and pitiful lookin'. Sort of a magpie Angus cross. Two cold hooves stuck out beneath her tail. It didn't look good. My colleagues introduced me to the Missus and explained, to my surprise, that she would be pleased to see the American method.

The chute was covered and had a concrete floor. Unfortunately, the floor was wider than the tin roof so the afternoon shower had left two inches of standing muck right where we laid the heifer down.

Soon I was wallowing about on my side in the slimy pool, arm deep inside trying to correct the 'head back' malpresentation. My two friends carried on a nonstop commentary describing my procedures to a preoccupied farm wife. She stood, arms folded across her chest as I splashed and scabbled for some leverage on the slick floor. They held the flashlight

and occasionally lent a boot for me to brace against as I pedaled like a three legged crab on glass.

We saved the heifer but lost the calf. I rode to the formal dinner in the backseat, my green underwear sticking to the upholstery. Needless to say, 'The American Method' was dinner conversation.

I was reminded of my Australian experience while listening to the African M.D. Yes, I told him, I could relate. I, too, had been to a foreign country where I didn't speak the language. But I was able to communicate with my patients. I guess it was because my language was universal. I speak cow.

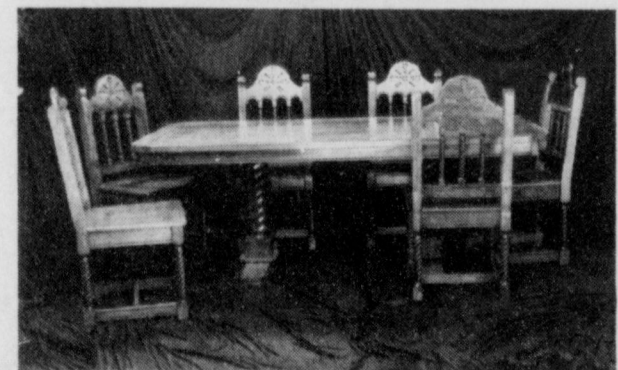
