when not planted．
Any normal skip－row pattern
should qualify as set－aside or di－
verted acreage．
Allotment reduction for non－
planting should not exceed the per
cent actually underplanted．
Set－aside acreage without pay．
ment should be set at the mini－
mum．
Stronger enforcement of work－
manlike manner of working cotton
