Colorado River Near Normal

Austin, Texas, Sept. 19.—The Colorado River is fast resuming its normal conditions, the recent flood having almost run out. With the passing of danger to the Austin dam from the flood, it now appears that the water supply of the city will be effected. Since Friday the city's water supply has come from the reservoir, no water being pumped into the city's mains from the filtering trenches. The reservoir consists of four quadrants, each of 2,500,000 gallons capacity and the last of the quadrants was opened yesterday. Two of the quadrants were emptied in two days and at this rate the last quadrant will be exhausted by tomorrow morning and water must then again be pumped from the filtering trenches.

It is feared that the flood has resulted in damage to filtering trenches and it is probable that when the pumping is resumed the mains will be filled with muddy water.

Milling Industry Reviving

Old steel plants all over the country that have been closed for years are being rehabilitated and put to work. Rush work has been ordered on new projects for the purpose of getting into the market while the picking is good.

Among the companies that have just completed a new plant and which is now in operation is the Youngstown Iron and Steel Company mill at Lowellville, Pa. Sheet bars are being rolled. Two furnaces of the American Steel Foundry Company, at Granite City, Ill, which have not been operated for two years, have also been started.

Wire manufacturers continue to be flooded with orders for barbed wire due to the extensive use in the great European struggle.

Scurry County Crops

A Signal man took an automobile spin (in a friend's car of course) last Sunday afternoon, through the Ira and Dunn regions. There is no better farming country anywhere. The people there are good farmers. Their crops are clean and most of the maize has been headed or cut and shocked. It looks like there is enough feed stuff for two years and the sucker crop in many fields is good. There is lots of maize and kafir yet to be gathered.

The cotton is fine and in the Ira community the fields are white and ready for pickers. Investigation fails to reveal the presence of any sort of pest in the cotton and the only question now is getting it gathered.


