## Railroads Urge Public Inquiry and Arbitration

The formal proposal of the railroads to the employes for the settlement of the controversy is as follows：

| ＂Our conferences have demonstrated that we cannot harmonize our diferences of opinion and that eventually the matters in controversy must be passed upon by other and disinterested agencies．Therefore，we propose that yourproposals and the proposition of the railways be disposed of by one or the other of the following methods： 1．Preferably by submission to the Interstate Commerce Commission，the only tribunal which，by reason of its accumulated information bearing on railway conditions and its control of the revenue of the railways，is in a posi－ tion to consider and protect the rights and equities of all the interests affected，and to provide additional revenue necessary to meet the added cost of operation in case your proposals are found by the Commission to be fust andreasonable；or，in the event the Interstate Commerce Commission cannot，under existing laws，act in the premises， that we jointly request Congress to take such action as may be necessary to enable the Commission to consider and promptly dispose of the questions involved；or |
