| year in sales of War Savings securities was 1918, when there was a strong patriotic appeal. The total for 1918 was $\$ 971,913,000$. During 1919, when the sales campaign was based on national thrift rather than patriotism $\$ 165,306,000$ was brought into the treasury, and in 1920 the total was $\$ 43,892,000$. Redemptions to date include $\$ 378,254,000$ of the 1918 series, $33,441,000$ of the 1919 series and $\$ 8,080,000$ of the 1920 issues. <br> Officials of the savings division point out that by far the greater proportion of the redemptions are of the 1918 series, which indicates that the more recent issues are being purchased by individuals who plan to hold them until maturity. <br> The certificates pay 4 per cent interest, compounded quarterly, which is equivalent to approximately $41-4$ per cent if held for the full five years. Those who present the certificates for redemption prior to the maturity date receive about 3 per cent interest. <br> AMARILLO MAN GETS <br> CONTRACT AT LAMESA. <br> The contract for the construction of a modern school building at Lamesa, to cost $\$ 60,000$ has been awarded to the Fred Bone Construction company of Amarillo, and work on the new building will begin April 20. L $\approx$ Taylor, architect of Lubbock was given the contract for the plans and specifications of the "proposed building. <br> The new school building at the Dawson county seat will be two stories and a basement, containing sixteen modern, steam heated, well ventilated rooms with a large and com- | HOCKIEY COUNTY RGYAB. <br> IASHES COUNTY SEAT. <br> Holding court under the shade of a mesquite tree in the newly-born but unbuilt town of Hockley City was the first official event in the recently organized county of Hockley a few days ago. The site of the town is in the heart of a great city of prairie dogs, one of the few communities of these little animals that still are to be found in West Texas. <br> When the legal formalities of forming the government for Hockley county were finished the members of the first coffmissioners' court found that they were called upon to establish a county seat. They picked this site, located near the center of the county, and accompanied by a few citizens, they came to what was then but a vacant spot in a big pasture and held court under the leafless branches of a mesquite tree. Standing near by were several white faced cattle that looked upon the strange proceedings with evident curiosity. At this time Hockley county has a population of 135 people. A railroad crosses one lower corner of it. It embraces 50,000 acres of level, prairie land which is said to be capable of producing abundant ylelds of wheat and other grains. <br> Already several tents have been set up in town and it is expected that the population will grow rapidly.
