itself is likely to throw all or a part of the city out of service for a time.

lines permit instant and almost unlimited increases in the amount of electric power which can be served a city. An isolated plant must
undergo drastic structural changes at great cost in order to increase undergo drastic structural changes at great cost in order to increase
