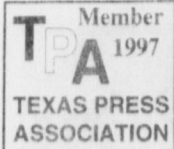
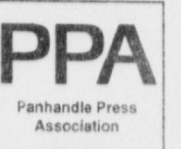

Bizzell accepts Farwell job

It was an opportunity that Muleshoe High School assistant principal Bill Bizzell felt he couldn't pass up.

Bizzell was named principal at Farwell High School earlier this month, replacing Larry Gregory, who was promoted to school superintendent.

He said he was approached by Gregory about applying for the Farwell job.

"I had no intentions of leaving (Muleshoe), but the opportunity to become a high school principal was something that I felt I owed to my family and myself."

Bizzell came to Muleshoe last year after 25 years in the Clovis, N.M. school system, the last nine as assistant high school principal.

He said he enjoyed his short stay here.

"It's a good community and I enjoyed working with the students," said Bizzell, who also had high praise for his boss, high school principal David Jenkins, and the whole Muleshoe school system.

The 49-year-old New Mexico native said he's still a young man.

"I feel like I have 10 or 15 more years left in my career, which leaves time to explore new challenges."

Cotton in desperate need of rain

MAPLE — Dryland cotton fields planted in parched soil to meet federal guidelines are in desperate shape as farmers are still waiting for the nurturing May rains.

Bailey County received about a 1/4 inch of rain Monday night, but it's not nearly enough to save dryland cotton from ruin according to one gin manager.

May is usually the wettest

month in West Texas, but less than half an inch has fallen in Bailey County so far this month.

"We need a good inch of rain real soon if we're going to have a chance of making a dryland crop," said Marvin McCaul, manager of the Maple Co-op Gin. "As a matter of fact, (Monday) night's rain probably hurt more than it helped."

Even though there is plenty of moisture 6-8 inches down in the soil due to winter rains, there is not enough surface moisture to allow the plants to get through the dry top soil.

Without more rain, McCaul said the seedlings would die soon.

Last year, one of the wettest Aprils on record helped Bailey County produce its first decent dryland crop since 1988.

Tooley's emotional, yet surprisingly non-traditional, speech during graduation ceremonies Friday evening reverberated the history of the nation as it has grown and prospered through good times and struggles, its majestic beauty, and the importance of its people, including the Three Way Class of 1998.

Tooley challenged his classmates to, "Love it (the nation), support its Constitution, obey its laws, respect it . . . and strive to do your best in bettering this great nation."

Tooley and the nine other graduates of Three Way High School were joined by hundreds of friends, families and community members to say good bye and thank you.

But farewell to high school didn't mean farewell to each other as salutatorian Russell Pollard pointed out: "We have grown up together. We have lived together. We have formed commitments to each other. We have won together and we have lost together. Now as we get ready to leave each other, the bonds are too strong to be broken."

Pollard continued his speech by thanking his classmates, family, and God. He reflected on how fortunate he and his classmates have been to have been a part of a school where the staff was more than just teachers, but also friends.

Then in a heartfelt tribute, Pollard thanked his late grandfather for pushing him to do his best.

Russell was not the only Pollard that took center stage during the ceremony. His uncle and Three Way graduate Howard Pollard was the guest speaker.

Senator draws crowd

Local citizens were given a rare opportunity Tuesday to quiz one of their U.S. Senators.

In front of a standing room only crowd during a luncheon at the Bailey County Coliseum, Sen. Kay Bailey Hutchison (R-Texas) spoke about the hot topics facing Congress — mainly taxes and social security.

Hutchison reassured the audience at the town hall meeting sponsored by the Muleshoe Rotary Club that major social security reform is on the horizon. "Anyone that has paid into the system, will have social security," she said emphatically.

Although positive about social security, Hutchison was not so optimistic on tax reform.

"Tax reform is definitely down the road, but it won't happen next year," the Senator said. "We can't negotiate with President Clinton. We will not have tax reform until after the next presidential election. We have to have a president that will make a commitment. Then, and only then, will we have tax reform."

Although a complete overhaul of the taxing system doesn't seem possible anytime soon, Hutchison said that Republicans are fighting hard to eliminate the inheritance tax.

"I don't ever want to meet someone who has to sell their farm or homestead to pay inheritance tax," she said. "We don't want to see anything partially confiscated when someone dies because their family has to pay this tax."

On the issue of health care, one local citizen questioned what the government was going to do in order to guarantee a patient's freedom of choice.

In her reply, Hutchison said she was concerned with the fact that patients can't always choose their own doctors. She added that ensuring the patient's right to be involved and make decisions concerning their medical care is definitely a priority.

The 30-minute presentation came to a close with a plea from one audience member to
