INCREASE IN OLEO.

A dispatch from Washington, D. C., announces that the annual report of the commissioner of internal revenue for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1910, shows a remarkable increase in the production of oleomargarine during the twelve months ending of the government's fiscal year.

This breaks the record by over 12,000,000 pounds. The figures which most nearly approached it are for 1902, when 126,316,427 pounds were made.

Even in view of this tax, however, and with the burden laid upon oleomargarine by the 10 cents per pound tax, when it is made with the color which is pleasing to the eye of the consumer, the figures for the past year show a tremendously growing demand for this food product.

There is no doubt that the high price of butter, which has been increasingly high in recent years, is largely the cause of the increased demand for oleomargarine.

separate the skin from the pulp, keeping them in separate dishes; put the pulp in your preserving kettle, with a teaspoonful of salt. When thoroughly heated run them through a colander to separate the seeds, then put your skins with them and weigh; to each pound of fruit add three-fourths of a pound of sugar; add merely water enough to keep from burning. Cook slowly three-fourths of an hour. This is a delicious jam and worth the trouble.

When the plums which are being carried over in the cellar are wanted for growth, set back closely, give them a thorough watering, and bring into the full light in a warm room. Roses brought out in January or February do very well.
