The work carried on during the past six years by the bureau of animal industry in cooperation with the state authorities has shown that the eradication of the cattle tick from the infected states is entirely feasible.

Only a part of the development of the tick takes place on the host; the rest of the development occurs on the pasture occupied by the host.

As all information which would assist in removing the greatest barrier to live-stock raising in the south, should prove of value to the future development and prosperity of the country now below the quarantine line, so also, is it of interest to the dealers and consumers of beef and beef products in all part of the country.

Maple Desserts—One cup of milk, three-quarters cup of maple syrup, one cup of sugar, one egg, one-half box gelatin, one pint of whipped cream, one dozen macaroons, one cup of nuts.

Fruit Pudding—Beat the yolks of four eggs with one cup sugar and two teaspoonfuls of gelatin.

Fruit Chop Suey—Crush one quart of strawberries, place in dishes, ready to serve, which have been lined with crisp lettuce leaves, garnish berries with small cubes of oranges.

Rice Pudding—Wash one cup rice thoroughly. Drop it in one quart boiling water. Let boil twenty minutes.

SALMON AND HORSE RADISH. Malted salmon with cucumber or horseradish sauce—One can salmon, one-half tablespoonful salt, one and one-half tablespoonfuls sugar, one-half tablespoonful flour, one teaspoonful mustard, few grains cayenne, yolks two eggs, one and one-half tablespoonfuls melted butter, three-quarters cup milk, one-quarter cup vinegar, three-quarters tablespoonful granulated gelatin, two tablespoonfuls cold water.
