CREAMED MUSHROOMS. Peel, cut up in thin slices, and wash about one pound of button mushrooms; stew for twelve minutes with about one-fourth pound of butter.

COLDS. Boil two ounces of flaxseed in one quart of water. Strain and add two ounces of rock candy, one-half pint of honey, juice of three lemons, let boil well.

FISH. First cut open and remove the gills and entrails, then salt well inside and out; roll in paper and place on ice for eight or ten hours.

TESTED RECIPES. Mush Biscuits—To one quart of boiling water add one teaspoonful of salt and one and one-fourth cupsful of corn meal.

BREAD. Corn Bread—One large tablespoonful of sugar, one-half cup of butter, one-half cup of milk, one-half cup of cream, two cups of flour.

COOKIES. Oatmeal Cookies—One cup brown sugar creamed with one-half cup lard and one-quarter cup butter.
