Red Termites Seek Shelter
On the statute books of the United States there is a
certan Voorhis act which requires registration with the
secretary of state for every organization subject to foreign
control, or which is engaged in political activities, or civ-
ilian-military activities, or whose purpose is to overthrow
the government by force, violence or threat. Negligence
so to register is punishable by heavy fine and imprison-
ment.
Faced by this law, the Communist Party of America
dissolved its organizational affiliation with the Commu-
nist International. But, at the same time, the leaders de-
nounced the Voorhis act as a Fascist law and satisfied
their old leanings by reaffirming their unshakable adher-
ence to "the proletarian internationalism of Marx, Engels,
Lenin and Stalin."

## That, of course, makes the whole proceeding smack of subterfuge. The Commmunsts evidently do not fancy United States authorities looking into their books, seeing how their organization works and whose money makes the how their organization works and whose money makes mare go. The finances of any party are important. Money is always necessary for the building up of a framework around which the believers and converts can gather. It around which the believers and converts can gather. is needed for the spread of literature. It is the thing which makes possible a party press. Small parties need such

from being a party patriot and making a present to the
party treasury. Small Communist parties, which might grow into big
ger and more dangerous ones, have existed before. In igerents, there is still a Communist party in Great Bri who makes himself vocal on any and all occasions.
So far, the American Communist Party has never elected a congressman, but it can always try to cash in
on monetary discontents and disappointments of the peo

The Louis Brandeis Way
Recently Louis D. Brandeis, who retired from the
United States Supreme Court in 1939 after 16 years of
great service, celebrated his 84 th birthday. He could look
back upon many years of success in the practice of his
profession, of fighting for great liberal causes, of cru-
sading for the under dog and of topping off his career
with a place on the bench of his country's greatest tribunal.
One of the Americans Brandeis has always admired
is Thomas Jefferson. Jeffersondin his time was member
of the Continental Congress, governor of Virginia, ne-
gotiator abroad of important treaties, secretary of state
under Washington, vice president under Adams and Presi-
dent himself for two terms. Yet when he came to write
his own simple epitaph, he omitted mention of all his
high offices.
He preferred this:
"Here was buried Thomas Jefferson, author of
the Declaration of Independence, of the Statute of
Virginia for Religious Freedom, and Father of the Uni-
versity of Virginio."
Mrs. Brandeis, asked what her distinguished husband
had been doing since his retirement from the bench, spoke
simple words which might well be his epitaph some day:
"He saw people and helped wherever he could."
