From Ofeen, N. C., Mrs. McKenney and I drove to High Point, N. C., and played in a duplicate game on Saturday afternoon at the High Point Country Club. Before the start of the game, C. M. Waynick, editor of the High Point Enterprise, called on me for a little talk, during which I emphasized the importance of the partnership tolerance. Then I sat down to play the first round with Mrs. McKenney against R. B. Terry, the publisher of the paper, and this hand came up. Mrs. McKenney held the North cards, and I sat South.

The bidding is given as it occurred at our table. We went down one trick as our opponents cashed the ace and king of clubs.

I criticized Mrs. McKenney, saying that she should pass five no trump. Her reply was that while it was true I could make five no trump, she thought it would be impossible for her to pass. She thought I should have passed five diamonds.

Well, of course, in tournament bridge match point scoring, to play a hand in diamonds if you can make five no trump would be a bad score. The argument went on pro and con, and we finally decided to take the hand up with some of the outstanding players of the country.

Oswald Jacoby said he would bid three diamonds instead of two diamonds, and then it might be possible to end in no trump. Waldemar von Zedwitz agreed to two diamonds. Over three hearts he would bid four diamonds. All the experts agreed that I should pass the five diamond bid even though I definitely knew that five no trump would be the best score, since it would be almost impossible for my partner to pass five no trumps.

Maybe you and your partner would like to argue out how the hand should be bid.

Secretary Knox Gives Talk At Navy College

NEWPORT, R. I., May 16—(AP)—Navy Secretary Knox said today "we intend to maintain our right of ever improving the lot of the common man even though we must waste our substance in wars of defense to maintain it."

Calling for a strong United States navy in time of peace as well as in war, he said in an address before a graduating class of the US Naval War College that a one-disarmed Germany had been enabled to challenge the world "only six short years" after Hitler became chancellor.
