## No Economics In A Vacuum

There has been a great deal of discussion of the pos
ble economic position of the United States in the case of a Hitler victory in Europe.
Could the United States, or could it not, compete with an economy managed from Germany which included
slave populations and resources throughout the whole of lave populations
One side of the argument says, no, that it would be ould have to adonterprise in the United States, which do business with the totalitarian principles in order to he United States, with all its resources, efficiency, kill, could compete with Germany under any circum tances, provided it keeps prices low, develops technique,

A great deal of this argument is unrealistic in tha
voids the central fact of trade under the Nazi system That fact, and it is a new fact in the study of economics is the complete intermingling of foreign policy, local pol-
tics, and economics with what used to be a simple competitive trade matter.

It might well be argued that the United States could ompete with the best a Nazi Germany could offer, even
f that system had the resources of a forcibly-united Eu rope at its disposal. Provided free competition were pos
sible, and provided that the United States were willing adjust its standard of living in some relationship to whatever standard of living the Nazis might impose on Europe, it might be possible. But it seems useless to make these calculations in a vacuum.

The Nazis have no idea of competing on what w have always regarded as a free basis with other econo mies. They worm their way in. They work internal po litical pressure to slant trade in favor of their economy
and this goes as far as internal revolution or the threa of it, to say nothing of bribery, "loss leader sates," ex clusive privileges, and every technique of political and so ial pressure which gives them the bulge on anyone wh wishes to compete as a matter of straight business. uld compete wtih a Nazi European economy State kind of a fair business basis are useless. The Nazis don, do business that way. They never have, and there is not the slightest sign that they ever intend to
