

McKENNEY ON BRIDGE

When Earl Ackerman of San Francisco, vice president of the Pacific Bridge League, visited New York, we dropped in to see Waldemar von Zedwitz, Oswald Jacoby, of the Four Aces, was also a guest.

Naturally, we discussed bridge hands. In describing the hand shown today, Jacoby said one of his opponents in a rubber bridge game "jumped out of the frying pan into the 1100 number." The

1100 number, of course, is the dreaded set of all bridge players.

The opening lead brought out the ten and jack of diamonds. Back came the queen of spades. South covered and the ace won. A spade return to the jack put Jacoby (East) in to lead the queen of hearts and the king was won by the ace.

West cashed the ten of spades, then led the eight, and Jacoby made his ten of clubs. He took the jack of hearts and led another. South ruffed low, instead of discarding the diamond, and West over-ruffed.

A diamond put East back to lead another heart, and West made his jack of trumps on an over-ruff. West excited with the diamond, and South made his low trump for his first trick. He cashed the ace of trumps, and West took the last trick with the king.

South was foolish to show his second suit when his partner passed one spade. East's double was not a business one. South should have passed to see what action West would take. Few suit bids of one are doubled for business.

If South had passed one spade doubled, West would have to figure whether more points could be gained by penalty or bidding. South's two club bid removed any doubts he may have held.

WICHITA FALLS (AP)—Joseph H. Barwise, 73, who as a boy helped lay out the route of the Fort Worth and Denver Railroad and later became its general attorney, died Sunday night, three days after suffering a heart attack.

He spent most of his mature years in railroading, starting out as chain-dragger with surveyors mapping the F. W. and D. he became a civil engineer and then a lawyer, receiving his degree in 1890. He was county attorney for Wichita County for two years after that and then returned to private practice.
